

John 8:52~ The Jews said to him; Now we do know you have a demon.¹ Abraham died, also the prophets, but you say; If anyone observes my word, he will never taste death at all.

Footnote: Or, you are demonized

1· Yet Jesus' words inflamed them even further, and again they said, that now they were sure that he had a demon. So they said that Abraham died, and also all the prophets, yet he had said that anyone who observes his word, would not taste death at all.

[Question] What effect did Jesus further words have upon these men, and so what did they say Jesus had within him?

[Question] What did they also relate about the men of faith of old times?

2· Many of them were saying; He has a demon and is mad. Why do you listen to him? (John 10:20)

[Question] What were many saying of Jesus, over the things he spoke?

3· Then Abraham expired and died in a good old age, old and satisfied, and was gathered to his people. (Genesis 25:8)

[Question] What is said about the faithful man Abraham when he died?

4· As for your fathers, where are they? And as for the prophets, was it to time indefinite that they continued to live? (Zechariah 1:5)

[Question] What did Zechariah state about the ancient prophets, though favored by Yehowah God?

5· Men, brothers, it is allowable to speak with freeness of speech to you concerning the family head David, that he both deceased and was buried and his tomb is among us to this day. (Acts of Apostles 2:29)

[Question] What did Peter relate about King David, and where he was to that very day?

6· In faith all these died, although they did not get the fulfillment of the promises, but they saw them afar off and welcomed them, and publicly declared, that they were

strangers and temporary residents in the land. (Hebrews 11:13)

[Question] What did all these men exercise in Yehowah God, yet did they in their lifetimes receive the fulfillment of the promises?

7· Truly I **say** to you that there are some of those standing here that **will not taste death** at all until first they see the Son of man coming in his kingdom. (**Matthew 16:28**)

[Question] What did Jesus though, state about some of his disciples and what they would see before dying?
