

John 8:55~ **And yet you have not known him. But I know him. And if I said I do not know him, I should be like you, a liar. But I do know him, and am observing his word.**

1· Then Jesus told these opposers, that they really did not know Yehowah God. Jesus however knew him, for he had lived in heaven alongside of him for eons of time, before ever coming to the earth as a man. So he told them, that if he were to say that he did not know Yehowah God, then he would be a liar if he did so. So he finished by telling them that he did know him, and was doing his will.

[Question] What did Jesus then tell his listeners, that they really did not know?

[Question] What did Jesus state that he himself would become, if he denied knowing Yehowah God intimately, for who had he existed alongside of for eons of time before that?

2· I know him, because I am a representative from him, and that One sent me forth. (John 7:29)

[Question] How did Jesus testify, that he really knew Yehowah God, like no other man knew him?

3· While he was yet speaking, look! A bright cloud overshadowed them, and, look! A voice out of the cloud, saying; This is my Son, the beloved, whom I have approved. Listen to him. (Matthew 17:5)

[Question] What voice gave glory to Jesus, upon the mountain of transfiguration?

4· Therefore Jesus cried out as he was teaching in the temple, and said; You both know me, and know where I am from. Also, I have not come of my own initiative, but he that sent me is real, and you do not know him. (John 7:28)

[Question] Who sent Jesus forth to mankind, and yet had the unfaithful Jews really come to know this one?

5· Righteous Father, the world, has indeed, not come to know you, but I have come to know you, and these have come to know that you sent me forth. (John 17:25)

[Question] What did Jesus show, that the world of mankind had indeed not yet come to know?

[Question] What though, did Jesus' disciples know about Jesus?
