He answered; The man called Jesus made a clay and smeared it on my eyes and said to me; Go to Siloam and wash. I therefore went and washed, and gained sight.

1· So he told them, that the man called Jesus, made a clay and smeared it upon his eyes, and then told him to go and wash in the pool of Siloam. He therefore obeyed Jesus and went and did this, and came back seeing.

[Question] What then, did the once blind man tell his questioners, as to how he was healed?

2· And **said to him; Go wash in the pool of Siloam, which is translated, **Sent forth**. And so he **went** off and **washed**, and came back seeing. (**John 9:7**)**

[Question] Where was the man told to go and wash his eyes, and what happened when he did?

3· As for the rest of the affairs of Hezekiah, and all his mightiness, and how he **made the pool and the conduit, and then brought the water into the city, are they not written in the book of the affairs of the days of the kings of Judah? (**2 Kings 20:20**)**

[Question] Who built this pool within the city of Jerusalem many years before?
