John 9:31~ We know that God does not listen to sinners, but if anyone is God-fearing and does his will, he listens to this one.

1. So the man stated, that even he knew that God does not listen to sinners, but if anyone is god-fearing and does God's will, this one he listens to.

[Question] What then, did the man testify, as to who Yehowah God assists, and listens to?

2. If I have regarded anything hurtful in my heart, Yehowah will not hear me. (Psalms 66:18)

[Question] What did the Psalmist show about his own heart, and his relationship to Yehowah God?

3. He that is turning his ear away from hearing the Law, even his prayer is something detestable. (Proverbs 28:9)

[Question] What is the prayer of someone like to Yehowah God, who turns his ear away from hearing the Law?

4. And when you spread out your palms, I hide my eyes from you. Even though you make many prayers, I am not listening, with bloodshed your very hands have become filled. (Isaiah 1:15)

[Question] What did Yehowah God show, through Isaiah, that he felt about bloodguilty men?

5. And I myself also shall act in rage. My eye will not feel sorry, neither shall I feel compassion. And they will certainly call out in my ears with a loud voice, but I shall not hear them. (Ezekiel 8:18)

[Question] What did Yehowah God show through Ezekiel, that he would not do towards his people in the time of Jerusalem's end?

6. At that time they will call to Yehowah for aid, but he will not answer them. And he will conceal his face from them in that time, according as they committed badness in their dealings. (Micah 3:4)

[Question] Why did Yehowah God show, that though his people would call out to him, he would not answer them?

7. And so it occurred, that just as he called and they did not listen, so they would call and I would not listen, Yehowah of armies has said. (Zechariah 7:13)

[Question] How did Yehowah God show, that he will react to people who do not listen to him?

8. The eyes of Yehowah are toward the righteous ones, and his ears are toward their cry for help. (Psalms 34:15)

[Question] Where are the eyes and ears of Yehowah God inclined towards?

9 Yehowah is far away from the wicked ones, but the prayer of the righteous ones he hears. (Proverbs 15:29)

[Question] Where is Yehowah God in relation to the wicked ones?

[Question] Whose prayer does he always hear?

10. But in every nation the man that fears him and works righteousness is acceptable to him. (Acts of Apostles 10:35)

[Question] Who is acceptable to Yehowah God in every nation on earth?

11: And you will certainly call me, and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. (Jeremiah 29:12)

[Question] What did Yehowah God promise to his repentant people?

12. And yet, at present, I know that as many things as you ask God for, God will give you. (John 11:22)

[Question] How did Martha express her faith in Jesus' relationship to his heavenly Father?

13. The man gazed at him and, becoming frightened, said; What is it, Lord? He said to him; Your prayers and gifts of mercy have ascended as a remembrance before God. (Acts of Apostles 10:4)

[Question] How did the angel appearing to Cornelius show, that Yehowah God had heard his prayers?

14. Therefore openly confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may get healed. A righteous

man's supplication, when it is at work, has much force. (James 5:16)

[Question] What should those in Yehowah God's favor do toward their brothers, and why?

15. And whatever we ask we receive from him, because we are observing his commandments, and are doing the things that are pleasing in his eyes. (1 John 3:22)

[Question] What confidence did anointed Christians have in prayers made to Yehowah God, and why?

16. And this is the confidence that we have toward him, that, no matter what it is that we ask according to his will, he hears us. (1 John 5:14)

[Question] What confidence do anointed Christians have, that Yehowah God hears all their prayers, and their deepest thoughts and feelings?
