

John 9:34~

In answer they said to him; You were altogether born in sins, and yet, are you teaching us? And they threw him out!

1· So they expressed their own scornful attitude about all others, and what others knew about God and his ways, saying, that this man had been born altogether in his sins, and so what did he know. Then they threw him out, for he had given a fine witness before them, one they could not reasonably refute.

[Question] What wrong and scornful attitude did the Pharisees then display, and what did they then do to the man, who had given a fine witness before them?

[Question] Could any one of the Pharisees refute in any way, what had taken place, though they tried desperately to do so?

2· And his disciples asked him; Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, so that he was born blind? (John 9:2)

[Question] What question did they ask of Jesus, upon seeing the man born blind, before Jesus healed him?

3· His parents said these things because they were in fear of the Jews, for the Jews had already come to an agreement, that if anyone confessed him as Christ, he should get expelled from the synagogue. (John 9:22)

[Question] Why were the man's parents fearful to bear witness respecting their son, and so what did they say?

4· Men will expel you from the synagogue. In fact, the hour is coming when everyone that kills you, will imagine he has rendered a sacred service to God. (John 16:2)

[Question] What hour did Jesus state was fast approaching, and what would men do to his disciples then?
