John 9:4~ We must work the works of him that sent me while it is day, the night is coming when no man can work.

1. So Jesus counseled them, that they must work the works of Yehowah God, the one that sent him forth, while it was day. Then he warned that the night was coming, and then no one would be able to work these works of light.

[Question] What works did Jesus state must be worked, and when?
[Question] What time did Jesus warn his disciples was approaching, and then would could not be done?

2. Jesus said to them; My food, is for me to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work. (John 4:34)

[Question] What did Jesus view as the food, that sustained him in life?

Jesus answered; There are twelve hours of daylight, are there not? If anyone walks in daylight he does not bump against anything, because he sees the light of this world. (John 11:9)

[Question] What illustration did Jesus give, to show when works of light must be performed?

4. Before I go away, and I shall not come back, to the land of darkness and deep shadow. (Job 10:21)

[Question] What did Job consider his present existence to be like?

5. All that your hand finds to do, do with your very power, for there is no work, nor devising, nor knowledge, nor wisdom in Sheol, the place to which you are going. (Ecclesiastes 9:10)

[Question] Why should men try to do fine works while they are alive?

6. In the morning sow your seed, and until the evening, do not let your hand rest, for you are not knowing where this will have success, either here or there, or whether both of them, will alike be good. (Ecclesiastes 11:6)

[Question] What optimistic outlook are we encouraged to have?

7. The living, the living, he is the one that can laud you, just

as I can this day. The father himself can give knowledge to his own sons concerning your trueness. (Isaiah 38:19)

[Question] What did faithful King Hezekiah say to show, that only the living laud Yehowah God?

8. Accordingly he went on preaching in the synagogues of Judea. (Luke 4:44)

[Question] Where did Jesus go forth preaching primarily?

9. But he answered them; My Father has kept working until now, and I keep working. (John 5:17)

[Question] What did Jesus keep doing right up until his death, and in imitation of whom?

10" For he says; In an acceptable time I heard you, and in a day of salvation I helped you. Look! Now, is the especially acceptable time. Look! Now, is the day of salvation. (2 Corinthians 6:2)

[Question] What day, did the apostle Paul show, that anointed Christians were currently in?

11. Really, then, as long as we have time favorable for it, let us work what is good toward all, but especially toward those related to us in the faith. (Galatians 6:10)

[Question] How should anointed Christians view the time they have before them, and how should they use this remaining time?
