John 9:5~ As long as I am in the world, I am the world's light.

1. So Jesus then compared himself to the world's light, for he was what made the day, out of the time that they were living in, and while it was day he would do these works, however the night was coming, when they would not be done.

[Question] What then, did Jesus compare himself to, and so what could men do while he was present, for what time was fast approaching?

2. And he proceeded to say; It has been more than a trivial matter for you to become my servant, to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to bring back even the safeguarded ones of Israel. I, also, have given you for a light of the nations, that my salvation may come to be, to the extremity of the earth. (Isaiah 49:6)

[Question] Was the bringing forth of Yehowah God's Messiah before mankind, a major part of the outworking of Yehowah God's grand purpose?

[Question] What was this one to serve as toward the nations, and to what end?

3. The spirit of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah is upon me, for the reason, that Yehowah has anointed me to tell Good News to the meek ones. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to those taken captive, and the wide opening of the eyes, even to the prisoners. (Isaiah 61:1)

[Question] For what purpose did Yehowah God anoint his son Jesus Christ on earth, and who primarily was he sent to assist?

4. And the light is shining in the darkness, but the darkness has not overpowered it. (John 1:5)

[Question] Where did the light of the Christ shine, and could the darkness of the present system of things overpower that light?

5. Therefore Jesus spoke again to them, saying; I, am the light of the world. He that follows me, will by no means walk in darkness, but will possess the light of life. (John 8:12)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples, that he himself was toward them and toward all the world?

[Question] What then, will those following Jesus not walk in, for what will they possess?

6' You are the light of the world. A city cannot be hid, when situated upon a mountain (Matthew 5:14)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his followers, that they also were to the world?

[Question] How then, did he illustrate, how to use that light?

7' Now this is the basis for judgment, that the light has come into the world, but men have loved the darkness, rather than the light, for their works were wicked. (John 3:19)

[Question] What did Jesus state would become the basis for judgment for mankind?

[Question] Why do men reject Jesus and his teachings?

8. I have come as a light into the world, in order, that everyone putting faith in me, may not remain in the darkness. (John 12:46)

[Question] What did Jesus come into the world as, and why?
