

**John 9:8~** Therefore the neighbors and those who formerly used to see he was a beggar, began to say; This is the man that used to sit and beg, is it not?

**1·** So because the man used to be a beggar, and many people knew him, those who recognized him said; Is this not the man that used to sit and beg?

**[Question]** Since the man was well known, what did many people say, upon seeing him healed?

**2·** Moreover, they **began** to recognize him, that this was the **man** that **used** to **sit** for gifts of mercy at the Beautiful Gate of the temple, and they became filled with astonishment and ecstasy, at what had happened to him. (**Acts of Apostles 3:10**)

**[Question]** What did the people recognize about this man, and how did they feel after seeing that he was well again?

**3·** And a certain **man** that was lame from his mother's womb was being carried, and they would daily put him near the temple door, that was called Beautiful, in order to ask gifts of mercy from those entering into the temple. (**Acts of Apostles 3:2**)

**[Question]** Where also did Peter and John find a man who was lame, and what did they do for him?
