Ephesians 1:10~ For an administration at the full limit of the appointed times, namely, to gather all things together again in the Christ, the things in the heavens and the things on the earth. Yes, in him.

1. This purpose of God, is for an administration, at the full limit of the appointed times, which will gather together again in the Christ, all things in heaven and on the earth, yes in Christ Jesus. This administration will manage all of God's household of creatures both in heaven and on the earth.

[Question] What is the purpose of God's administration, for both heaven and earth?

[Question] What then, will this administration manage in heaven, and on earth?

2. Look! A king will reign for righteousness itself, and as respects princes, they will rule as princes for justice itself. (Isaiah 32:1)

[Question] What did Isaiah prophesy about a future king, and the princes serving under him?

3. And should make men see, how the sacred secret is administered which has from the indefinite past been hidden in God, who created all things. (Ephesians 3:9)

[Question] Where has this sacred secret been hidden since the beginning, and who is privileged to reveal it now?

4. But Christ was faithful as a Son over the house of that One. We are the house of that One, if we make fast our hold on our freeness of speech, and our boasting over the hope, firm to the end. (Hebrews 3:6)

[Question] What are anointed Christians, and who oversees and builds this house?

[Question] What must we anointed sons of God maintain throughout our lives, and through what fine work do we do this?

5. Happy and holy is anyone having part in the first resurrection, over these the second death has no authority, but they will be priests of God and of the Christ, and will rule as kings with him for the thousand years. (Revelation 20:6)

[Question] What has no authority over those who are resurrected as part of the first resurrection?

[Question] What work will they then do, for the thousand years?

6. And they will fall by the edge of the sword and be led captive into all the nations, and Jerusalem will be trampled on by the nations, until the appointed times of the nations are fulfilled. (Luke 21:24)

[Question] What did Jesus Christ foretell for the Jewish nation, until the Gentile Times ended?

7. He said to them; It does not belong to you to get knowledge of the times or seasons, which the Father has placed in his own jurisdiction. (Acts of Apostles 1:7)

[Question] What things does Yehowah God keep within his own jurisdiction?

8. Gather to me my loyal ones, those concluding my covenant over sacrifice. (Psalms 50:5)

[Question] What are these ones concluding a covenant to Yehowah God over sacrifice?

9. But when all things will have been subjected to him, then the Son himself will also subject himself to the One, who subjected all things to him, that God may be all things to everyone. (1 Corinthians 15:28)

[Question] What will Jesus Christ do with Kingdom authority, after the end of the thousand years?

10" And through him to reconcile again to himself all other things, by making peace through the blood he shed on the torture stake, no matter whether they are the things upon the earth, or the things in the heavens. (Colossians 1:20)

[Question] What things, in what places, will be reconciled to God through Christ Jesus?

11. To an incorruptible and undefiled and unfading inheritance. It is reserved in the heavens for you. (1 Peter 1:4)

[Question] What kind of an inheritance is reserved where for anointed Christians?

12. And I have other sheep, which are not of this fold, those also I must bring, and they will listen to my voice, and they will become one flock, one shepherd. (John 10:16)

[Question] What other sheep besides the anointed ones will later become part of the sheepfold of Jesus Christ?

[Question] Whose voice must they listen to, to gain entrance there?

13. So that in the name of Jesus every knee should bend, of those in heaven, and those on earth, and those under the ground. (Philippians 2:10)

[Question] Whose knees will bend to the name of Jesus Christ?

14. And he went on to say to me; Son of man, as regards these bones, they are the whole house of Israel. Here they are saying; Our bones have become dry, and our hope has perished. We have been severed off to ourselves. (Ezekiel 37:11)

[Question] What vision of Ezekiel pictured the coming to life of the anointed congregation in modern times?

15. And saying; The appointed time has been fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has drawn near. Be repentant, you people, and have faith in the Good News. (Mark 1:15)

[Question] What time has drawn even nearer today, and so how should people react to God's undeserved kindness?

16. And I heard a loud voice in heaven say; Now have come to pass the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God and the authority of his Christ, because the accuser of our brothers has been hurled down, who accuses them day and night before our God! (Revelation 12:10)

[Question] What proclamation is made in heaven after the fact, when Satan the Devil is hurled down?

17. Because they poured out the blood of holy ones and of

prophets, and you have given them blood to drink. They deserve it. (Revelation 16:6)

[Question] Why does Yehowah God give the ones who killed his anointed sons, blood to drink?

18. And in the days of those kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom that will never be brought to ruin. And the kingdom itself will not be passed on to any other people. It will crush and put an end to all these kingdoms, and it itself will stand to times indefinite. (Daniel 2:44)

[Question] What Kingdom does Yehowah promise to set up, and how long will it last for mankind?

[Question] What will it do to all the other kingdoms of the earth, when it comes to power?
