- 3· We thank God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ always when we pray for you. (**Colossians 1:3**)

[Question] What did Paul always thank his God for?

- 4· That is also why we, from the day we heard of it, have not ceased praying for you, and asking that you may be filled with the accurate knowledge of his will, in all wisdom and spiritual comprehension. (**Colossians 1:9**)

[Question] What did Paul ask for his anointed spiritual brothers to be filled with?

- 5· We always thank God, when we make mention concerning all of you, in our prayers. (**1 Thessalonians 1:2**)

[Question] What did Paul always make mention of in his prayers?

- 6· I always thank my God, when I make mention of you in my prayers. (**Philemon 1:4**)

[Question] What did Paul also thank God for?
