Ephesians 1:19~ And what the surpassing greatness of his power is toward us believers. It is according to the operation of the mightiness of his strength.

1. Paul also wants them to understand, what the surpassing greatness of his power is, that is operating towards believers. His spirit operates according to the mightiness of his strength, and he is the Almighty God.

[Question] What surpassing power does Yehowah God have, and demonstrate toward anointed ones?

2. True, indeed, he was impaled owing to weakness, but he is alive owing to God's power. True, also, we are weak with him, but we shall live together with him, owing to God's power toward you. (2 Corinthians 13:4)

[Question] Why is Christ alive today?

[Question] Though weak at present, what can anointed Christians expect for the future?

3. To this end I am indeed working hard, exerting myself in accordance with the operation of him, and which is at work in me, with power. (Colossians 1:29)

[Question] How did Paul find the strength to keep working hard in the truth?

4. The riches and the glory are on account of you, and you are dominating everything. In your hand there are power and mightiness, and in your hand is ability to make great, and to give strength to all. (1 Chronicles 29:12)

[Question] What is in Yehowah hand to perform whatever he wants or purposes to do?

5' Yehowah is slow to anger and great in power, and by no means will Yehowah hold back from punishing. In destructive wind and in storm is his way, and the cloud mass is the powder of his feet. (Nahum 1:3)

[Question] What is Yehowah God great in?

6. But God both raised up the Lord, and will raise us up out of death, through his power. (1 Corinthians 6:14)

[Question] Through what glorious power, was Christ raised up, and what can anointed Christians also expect similarly?

7. However, we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the power beyond what is normal, may be God's, and not that out of ourselves. (2 Corinthians 4:7)

[Question] What treasure do anointed Christians have while on earth in a fleshly body?

8. Who will refashion our humiliated body to be conformed to his glorious body, according to the operation of the power that he has, even to subject all things to himself.

(Philippians 3:21)

[Question] What will he do through this wonderful power, and what kind of a body will we then gain?

9. For you were buried with him in his baptism, and by relationship with him you were also raised up together through your faith in the operation of God, who raised him up from the dead. (Colossians 2:12)

[Question] What course are all anointed Christians taking by baptism?
[Question] Once successfully finishing our earthly lives, what can we expect, like Christ received?
