Ephesians 1:20~ With which he has operated in the case of the Christ when he raised him up from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly places.

1. This glorious power was manifested in Christ himself, when God raised him up from the dead, when wicked men had killed him without justice. God declared him righteous in his eyes, and loosed the pangs of death from Jesus Christ, and then seated him at his own right hand of power, in the heavenly places.

[Question] How was God's glorious power first manifest to anointed Christians?

[Question] Why would Yehowah God not allow his son to stay dead in Sheol, the grave?

[Question] What then, did God declare him to be, and where did he raise him up to?

2. This glorious power was also demonstrated by Jesus Christ many times throughout his earthly ministry, when he restored a man's withered hand, cured the blind, cured leprosy and raised up the dead. There is nothing, that can happen to Christians, that God cannot fix or restore!

[Question] How was the glorious power of God made manifest many times throughout Jesus' earthly ministry?

3. But God resurrected him by loosing the pangs of death, because it was not possible, for him to continue to be held fast by it. (Acts of Apostles 2:24)

[Question] Why did Yehowah God loose the pangs of death holding his son, Jesus Christ?

4. The utterance of Yehowah to my Lord is; Sit at my right hand, until I place your enemies, as a stool for your feet. (Psalms 110:1)

[Question] Where does Christ sit, and awaiting what?

5. But he, being full of Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven and caught sight of God's glory, and of Jesus standing at God's right hand. (Acts of Apostles 7:55)

[Question] What vision of Jesus Christ, did Stephen see at his death?

6. And he raised us up together, and seated us together in the heavenly places, in union with Christ Jesus. (Ephesians 2:6)

[Question] Where has God raised up his anointed congregation to, in union with whom?

7' For such a High Priest as this was suitable for us, loyal, guileless, undefiled, separated from the sinners, and become higher than the heavens. (Hebrews 7:26)

[Question] Why is Jesus Christ a suitable High Priest for all mankind?

3. Joseph now took the two of them, Ephraim by his right hand to Israel's left, and Manasseh by his left hand to Israel's right, and brought them close to him. (Genesis 48:13)

[Question] What blessing fell upon Joseph's two sons, as firstborn of Israel?

9. Then Jesus said; I am, and you persons will see the Son of man sitting at the right hand of power, and coming with the clouds of heaven. (Mark 14:62)

[Question] What did Jesus state they would see in the future regarding him?

10" And he said; Look! I behold the heavens opened up, and the Son of man standing at God's right hand. (Acts of Apostles 7:56)

[Question] What did Stephen bear witness to seeing just before he died?

11. He sent out the word to the sons of Israel to declare to them the Good News of peace through Jesus Christ. This One is Lord of all others. (Acts of Apostles 10:36)

[Question] What is Jesus Christ Lord of?

12. But God both raised up the Lord, and will raise us up out of death through his power. (1 Corinthians 6:14)

[Question] What confidence do anointed Christians have regarding the resurrection, and what do they base this upon?
