

**Ephesians 1:22~** He also subjected all things under his feet, and made him head over all things to the congregation.

- 1· God also has subjected all things under Christ's feet and made Christ the head of the congregation of God, the 144,000 spirit anointed sons of God.

[Question] What things has God subjected under Christ's feet?

[Question] What also, is he the head of?

- 2· You make him dominate over the works of your hands, everything you have put **under** his **feet**. (**Psalms 8:6**)

[Question] What things has he made subject to all mankind?

- 3· And Jesus approached and spoke to them, saying; All authority has been given me, in heaven and on the earth. (**Matthew 28:18**)

[Question] What was given to Jesus Christ after his resurrection?

- 4· Because a husband is **head** of his wife, as the Christ also is **head** of the **congregation**, he being a savior of this body. (**Ephesians 5:23**)

[Question] Who is the head of the Christian congregation?

- 5· And he is the **head** of the body, the **congregation**. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that he might become the one, who is first in all **things**. (**Colossians 1:18**)

[Question] Who is the head of the Christian congregation?

[Question] Why was Jesus Christ the firstborn from the dead?

- 6· And to him there were given rulership and dignity and kingdom, that the peoples, national groups and languages should all serve even him. His rulership is an indefinitely lasting rulership, that will not pass away, and his kingdom one, that will not be brought to ruin. (**Daniel 7:14**)

[Question] What was given to Christ, and for what purpose?

[Question] How long, will his rulership last for?

- 7· For God, subjected all **things under** his feet. But when he says that **all things have been subjected**, it is evident, that

it is with the exception of the one, who subjected all **things** to him. (**1 Corinthians 15:27**)

**[Question]** What things have been subjected under Christ, with the one exception of whom?

- 8· Whereas he is not holding fast to the **head**, to the one from whom all the body, being supplied and harmoniously joined together, by means of its joints and ligaments, goes on growing with the growth that God gives. (**Colossians 2:19**)

**[Question]** Who gives growth to all the body, and who is this one within the Christian body of anointed ones?

- 9· All **things** you subjected **under** his feet. For in that he subjected all **things** to him, God left nothing that is not subject to him. Now, though, we do not yet see all **things** in subjection to him. (**Hebrews 2:8**)

**[Question]** What has not been subjected under Christ's feet?

**[Question]** Do we currently see this condition, in the world around us?
