

Ephesians 1:5~ For he foreordained¹ us to the adoption through Jesus Christ as sons to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will.

Footnote: Or, without blemish before him For in love (5) he foreordained

- 1· God foreordained, that anointed Christians would come to be his sons through adoption, for this is his will, and he takes pleasure in doing such glorious things in our behalf.**

[Question] What did God foreordain for anointed sons, through what?

- 2· However, we are obligated to thank God always for you, brothers loved by Yehowah, because God selected you from the beginning for salvation, by sanctifying you with spirit, and by your faith in the truth. (2 Thessalonians 2:13)**

[Question] Who alone selects which sons will be anointed, and how does the selection become manifest to each one of them?

[Question] What alone is first required of each anointed son?

- 3· According to the foreknowledge of God the Father, with sanctification by the spirit, for the purpose of their being obedient and sprinkled with the blood of Jesus Christ. May undeserved kindness and peace be increased to you. (1 Peter 1:2)**

[Question] According to whose foreknowledge, are anointed Christians chosen and sanctified by Holy Spirit?

- 4· For you did not receive a spirit of slavery causing fear again, but you received a spirit of adoption as sons, by which spirit we cry out; Abba, Father! (Romans 8:15)**

[Question] What kind of a spirit, is the one that welcomes true anointed sons to the adoption as sons of God, and how do we respond to it?

- 5· Because those whom he gave his first recognition, he also foreordained to be patterned after the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. (Romans 8:29)**

[Question] What did Yehowah God foreordain for these anointed sons to be patterned after, and so what does Christ become among many?

- 6· That he might release by purchase those under Law, that**

we, in turn, might receive the **adoption** as **sons**. (**Galatians 4:5**)

[Question] What prior covenant does the anointing release anointed sons of God from, thus freeing them for what?

- 7· Not only that, but we ourselves also who have the firstfruits, namely, the spirit, yes, we ourselves groan within ourselves, while we are earnestly waiting for **adoption** as **sons**, the release from our bodies by ransom. (**Romans 8:23**)

[Question] What are the firstfruits of heavenly life?

[Question] How do anointed sons of God feel while awaiting the glories of the spirit in heaven?

- 8· Now we know that God makes all his works cooperate together for the **good** of those who love God, those who are the ones called according to his purpose. (**Romans 8:28**)

[Question] What does God make all his works do toward one another?

- 9· However, as many as did receive him, to them he gave authority to become God's children, because they were exercising faith in his name. (**John 1:12**)

[Question] Why were certain ones selected to become sons of God, for what were they exercising?

- 10· Moreover, those whom he foreordained are the ones he also called, and those whom he called are the ones he also declared to be righteous. Finally those whom he declared righteous are the ones he also glorified. (**Romans 8:30**)

[Question] Who are the ones he called, and later declared to be righteous?

[Question] Who will he glorify, once they finish their earthly life course?

- 11· For we are a product of his work and were created in union with **Christ Jesus** for **good** works, which God prepared in advance for us to walk in them. (**Ephesians 2:10**)

[Question] What are anointed Christians, and what were we created for?

- 12· Beloved ones, now we are children of God, but as yet it has not been made manifest what we shall be. We do know that whenever he is made manifest we shall be like him, because we shall see him just as he is. (1 John 3:2)**

[Question] What are we even now, through spirit anointing while on earth?

[Question] What will we later become, yet what do we know about that state of being?
