

Ephesians 1:6~ In praise of his glorious undeserved kindness, which he kindly conferred upon us by means of his loved one.

- 1· Paul now wants to extend his praise to his God for this glorious undeserved kindness of God, which he kindly conferred upon Christians through his son, Jesus Christ.

[Question] What does Paul now bless Yehowah God for?

- 2· The people whom I have formed for myself, that they should recount the praise of me. (**Isaiah 43:21**)

[Question] Why did Yehowah God bring 144,000 sons to himself through adoption?

- 3· And it is as a free gift, that they are being declared righteous by his **undeserved kindness**, through the release by the ransom paid by Christ Jesus. (**Romans 3:24**)

[Question] How does the declaration of righteousness come to anointed sons?

- 4· The Father loves the Son, and has given all things into his hand. (**John 3:35**)

[Question] What things has the father given to the son, and why?

- 5· But as for me, I shall sing of your strength, and in the morning I shall joyfully tell about your loving-kindness. For you have proved to be a secure height for me, and a place to which to flee in the day of my distress. (**Psalms 59:16**)

[Question] How did anointed sons feel as expressed by the Psalmist?

- 6· For the one finding me will certainly find life, and gets goodwill from Yehowah. (**Proverbs 8:35**)

[Question] What will the one finding divine wisdom gain?

- 7· For we all received from out of his fullness, even **undeserved kindness** upon **undeserved kindness**. (**John 1:16**)

[Question] What fullness, have all anointed Christians received out of?
