Ephesians 1:7~ By means of him we have the release by ransom through the blood of that one, yes, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his undeserved kindness.

1. By means of Jesus Christ, Christians have a release from sin and death, by means of the ransom of Jesus Christ, yes also the forgiveness of sins, through this wonderful undeserved kindness of God. Through God's richness of undeserved kindness, he had freely forgiven Christians their trespasses against him, and brought them to the adoption, as sons to himself.

[Question] What do anointed Christians receive a release from through Jesus Christ?

[Question] What does this come to us on the basis of?

2. Pay attention to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has appointed you overseers, to shepherd the congregation of God, which he purchased with the blood of his own Son. (Acts of Apostles 20:28)

[Question] Through whose blood, was the congregation purchased back from sin and death?

God set him forth as an offering for propitiation through faith in his blood. This was in order to exhibit his own righteousness, because he was forgiving the sins that occurred in the past, while God was exercising forbearance. (Romans 3:25)

[Question] What kind of an offering is Jesus Christ's?

4. And they sing a new song, saying; You are worthy to take the scroll and open its seals, because you were slaughtered and with your blood you bought persons for God out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation. (Revelation 5:9)

[Question] Why is the Christ found worthy to open the understanding of the scrolls?

[Question] What did Jesus Christ buy with his shed blood, and from where?

5. Let it therefore be known to you, brothers, that through

this One, a forgiveness of sins is being published to you. (Acts of Apostles 13:38)

[Question] What was Paul publishing through Jesus Christ?

6. By means of whom we have our release by ransom, the forgiveness of our sins. (Colossians 1:14)

[Question] What release does the blood of Jesus Christ free anointed Christians from?

7' Furthermore, though you were dead in your trespasses and in the uncircumcised state of your flesh, God made you alive together with him. He kindly forgave us all our trespasses (Colossians 2:13)

[Question] What was the state of Gentile anointed Christians, before becoming sons of God the adoption?

8. For we all received from out of his fullness, even undeserved kindness upon undeserved kindness. (John 1:16)

[Question] What have all anointed ones received out of Christ's fullness?

9. And they must take some of the blood and splash it upon the two doorposts and the upper part of the doorway belonging to the houses, in which they will eat it. (Exodus 12:7)

[Question] How did the shed blood of the Passover Lamb, foreshadow the work of the Christ?

10" And he must do to the bull just as he did to the other bull of the sin offering. That is the way he will do to it, and the priest must make an atonement for them, and so, it must be forgiven them. (Leviticus 4:20)

[Question] What atonement was practiced under the Law Covenant, and what did it point to?

11. And the goat must carry upon itself all their errors into a desert land, and he must send the goat away into the wilderness. (Leviticus 16:22)

[Question] The goat that was sacrificed representing sins of the past, indicated what about their past sins?

[Question] What happened to the goat that was not sacrificed, indicating what about sin, and rebelliousness that caused it, in the future?

12. And he must bathe his flesh in water in a holy place and put on his garments and come out and render up his burnt offering and the people's burnt offering and make atonement in his own behalf and in behalf of the people. (Leviticus 16:24)

[Question] For whose behalf did the High Priest make atonement?

13. For the soul of the flesh is in the blood, and I myself have put it upon the altar for you to make atonement for your souls, because it is the blood that makes atonement by the soul in it. (Leviticus 17:11)

[Question] What is in the blood of a soul, and what makes atonement before God for a soul?

14. At that Naomi said to her daughter-in-Law; Blessed be he of Yehowah, who has not left his loving-kindness toward the living and the dead. And Naomi went on to say to her; The man is related to us. He is one of our repurchasers. (Ruth 2:20)

[Question] Why did Naomi bless Yehowah, for who was Boaz in relation to her?

15. Let Israel keep waiting for Yehowah. For there is lovingkindness with Yehowah, and abundantly so, is there redemption with him. (Psalms 130:7)

[Question] What things reside with Yehowah God abundantly?

16. She will give birth to a son, and you must call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins. (Matthew 1:21)

[Question] What future role was Jesus Christ set to play out for the Jewish nation, and later all mankind?

17: For this means my blood of the covenant, which is to be poured out in behalf of many for forgiveness of sins.

(Matthew 26:28)

[Question] Why was Jesus Christ's blood poured out?

18. Peter said to them; Repent, and let each one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the free gift of the Holy Spirit. (Acts of Apostles 2:38)

[Question] What course did Peter set before those listening to him?

[Question] What then sealed them as sons of God, for what belonging to God was put within each one of them?

19. Or do you despise the riches of his kindness and forbearance and long-suffering, because you do not know that the kindly quality of God is trying to lead you to repentance? (Romans 2:4)

[Question] What is the kindly quality of God and his wonderful patience, trying to lead mankind to?

20. And it is as a free gift that they are being declared righteous by his undeserved kindness, through the release, by the ransom paid by Christ Jesus. (Romans 3:24)

[Question] How does the ransom come forth to faithful ones, as what?

21. Now if it is by undeserved kindness, it is no longer due to works, otherwise, the undeserved kindness, no longer proves to be undeserved kindness. (Romans 11:6)

[Question] What does the gift come forth as, and why is it not according to works?

22. I always thank God for you, in view of the undeserved kindness of God given to you in Christ Jesus. (1 Corinthians 1:4)

[Question] Why did Paul always thank God for his anointed brothers?

23. For as often as you eat this loaf and drink this cup, you keep proclaiming the death of the Lord, until he arrives. (1 Corinthians 11:26)

[Question] What does the repeated eating and drinking of the symbolic emblems of the Lord's Supper, keep proclaiming, and until when?

24. That in the coming systems of things there might be demonstrated, the surpassing riches of his undeserved kindness, in his graciousness toward us in union with Christ Jesus. (Ephesians 2:7)

[Question] What will be demonstrated toward anointed sons of God, in the coming system of things?

25. In turn, my God will fully supply all your need, to the extent of his riches, in glory, by means of Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:19)

[Question] What riches does Yehowah God have to help his anointed sons in their course in life?

26' Who gave himself for us, that he might deliver us from every sort of lawlessness, and cleanse for himself a people peculiarly his own, zealous for fine works. (Titus 2:14)

[Question] Why did Jesus Christ give himself for anointed ones?

27. Yes, nearly all things are cleansed with blood according to the Law, and unless blood is poured out no forgiveness takes place. (Hebrews 9:22)

[Question] What is cleansing, and what must be poured out for forgiveness to take place?

28. However, if we are walking in the light as he himself is in the light, we do have a sharing with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. (1 John 1:7)

[Question] What are those who are walking in the light, being cleansed from completely?

29. This is he that came by means of water and blood, Jesus Christ. Not with the water only, but with the water and with the blood. And the spirit is that which is bearing witness, because the spirit is the truth. (1 John 5:6)

[Question] What did the water outside of the tent of meeting represent for anointed Christians?
