

Ephesians 2:1~ Furthermore, it is you, God made alive, though you were dead in your trespasses and sins.

- 1• Spirit anointed Christians were dead in their trespasses and sins before they heard of the Good News of God. However, God made them alive, though this state was a state of death, because they were still in their trespasses and sins. He did this through the the gift of his spirit, which gives them a living hope, through the forgiveness of their sins.

[Question] What was the condition of spirit anointed sons, before hearing the Good News of God?

[Question] How did Yehowah God then, make them alive before him?

- 2• Jesus said to him; Keep following me, and let the **dead** bury their dead. (**Matthew 8:22**)

[Question] What course was Christ on, and how did he denote this to his disciples?

- 3• Furthermore, though you were **dead** in your **trespasses** and in the uncircumcised state of your flesh, **God made you alive** together with him. He kindly forgave us all our **trespasses**. (**Colossians 2:13**)

[Question] What course were anointed Christians on, before becoming such?

[Question] What did God forgive them for, thus bringing them to life before him?

- 4• But the one that goes in for sensual gratification is **dead**, though she is living. (**1 Timothy 5:6**)

[Question] What is the condition of one who still follows the desires of the fallen flesh, after becoming an anointed Christian?

- 5• In fact, for this purpose the Good News was declared also to the **dead**, that they might be judged as to the flesh from the standpoint of men, but might live as to the spirit, from the standpoint of **God**. (**1 Peter 4:6**)

[Question] Why was the Good News also declared to the dead?

- 6• And he will certainly render judgment among the nations and set matters straight respecting many peoples. And

they will have to beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning shears. Nation will not lift up sword against nation, neither will they learn war anymore. **(Isaiah 2:4)**

[Question] What did Yehowah promise to do for mankind those Isaiah?

[Question] What then, will mankind not learn ever again, after the start of the thousand years?

- 7· But he said to him; Let the **dead** bury their **dead**, but you go away, and declare abroad the kingdom of God. **(Luke 9:60)**

[Question] What course were anointed Christians on, and so what counsel did Jesus give to them?

- 8· Because this my son was **dead** and came to life again, he was lost and was found. And they started to enjoy themselves. **(Luke 15:24)**

[Question] How did the father in Jesus parable, treat the return of his wayward son?

- 9· Just as it is written: I have appointed you a father of many nations. This was in the sight of the One, in whom he had faith, even of **God**, who makes the **dead alive**, and calls the things that are not, as though they were. **(Romans 4:17)**

[Question] What did Yehowah God call Abraham, though at the time he was childless and quite old?

- 10· For even we were once senseless, disobedient, being misled, being slaves to various desires and pleasures, carrying on in badness and envy, abhorrent, hating one another. **(Titus 3:3)**

[Question] How did anointed Christians act themselves before becoming anointed ones?

- 11· The rest of the **dead** did not come to life until the thousand years were ended. This is the first resurrection. **(Revelation 20:5)**

[Question] When will the remainder of the dead come to life, according to the Scriptures?
