

Ephesians 2:15~ By means of his flesh he abolished the enmity, the Law of commandments consisting in decrees, that he might create the two peoples in union with himself into one new man and make peace.

- 1• Christ, by means of his flesh abolished the enmity, the Law Covenant of commandments consisting of decrees, with punishments for failure to comply with its commands. This was done, so that these two disparate peoples, could be joined together in union with himself, into one new man, the body of the Christ.

[Question] What did Christ abolish through his flesh in sacrifice?

[Question] Why did he do this?

- 2• For, there being an incapability on the part of the Law, while it was weak through the flesh, God, by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and concerning sin, condemned sin in the flesh. (Romans 8:3)

[Question] What was the Law Covenant incapable of making men do, because the flesh is self-serving?

[Question] What did Yehowah God condemn, by sending his son concerning sin?

- 3• In reply, however, she said to him; Yes, sir, and yet the little dogs underneath the table eat of the crumbs of the little children. (Mark 7:28)

[Question] How did the foreign woman show Jesus Christ, that she got the point of his illustration, was a spiritual person, and so what did he do for her anyway?

- 4• And what great nation is there, that has righteous regulations and judicial decisions, like all this Law, that I am putting before you today? (Deuteronomy 4:8)

[Question] How did Moses feel, about the wonderful Law he was given by God?

- 5• But glory and honor and peace for everyone who works what is good, for the Jew first, and also for the Greek. (Romans 2:10)

[Question] What comes from God to the Jew first, and also to the Greek?

- 6· For just as the body is one but has many members, and all the members of that body, although being many, are one body, so also is the Christ. (1 Corinthians 12:12)

[Question] What is the body made up of, and yet how does the body act toward all its members, and the members act toward the entire body?

- 7· And you must keep this thing as a regulation for you, and your sons to time indefinite. (Exodus 12:24)

[Question] What were the Jews to keep to time indefinite, and how does the Lord's Supper continue it, in a new form?

- 8· But now we have been discharged from the Law, because we have died to that by which we were being held fast, that we might be slaves in a new sense, by the spirit, and not in the old sense, by the written code. (Romans 7:6)

[Question] How could anointed Christians now feel, that they were dead to the Law Covenant?

[Question] Do anointed Christians still keep the principles of the Law Covenant, yet how?

- 9· For Christ is the end of the Law, so that everyone exercising faith may have righteousness. (Romans 10:4)

[Question] What is Christ regarding the Law Covenant?

[Question] What comes through Christ, for everyone exercising faith?

- 10· But their mental powers were dulled. For to this present day, the same veil remains unlifted, at the reading of the old covenant, because it is done away with, by means of Christ. (2 Corinthians 3:14)

[Question] What did the veiling of Moses' face represent, even down to today for the Jews?

- 11· The purpose was, that the blessing of Abraham might come to be by means of Jesus Christ, for the nations, that we might receive the promised spirit, through our faith. (Galatians 3:14)

[Question] Whose blessing comes to be for the nations of the earth, and how, and through whom?

- 12· And blotted out the handwritten document against us, which consisted of **decrees** and which was in opposition to us, and He has taken it out of the way, by nailing it to the torture stake. (**Colossians 2:14**)

[Question] What also was nailed to the torture stake of the Christ, thus putting an end to it, for Jewish anointed Christians?

- 13· If you died together with Christ toward the elementary things of the world, why do you, as if living in the world, further subject yourselves to the **decrees**. (**Colossians 2:20**)

[Question] What does acceptance of Christ put us to death in reference to?

- 14· Also, let the **peace** of the Christ control in your hearts, for you were, in fact, called to it in one body. And show yourselves thankful. (**Colossians 3:15**)

[Question] What should now control in our hearts, and what division no longer exists?
