Ephesians 2:17~ And he came and declared the Good News of peace to you, the ones far off, and peace to those near.

1. Then Christ came and declared the Good News of peace to anointed Gentile Christians, who were then the ones far off from God's clean and holy way of worship, and also peace to the Jewish Christians, who were the ones near to the way of true worship.

[Question] How did this reconcile peoples who were far, and also those who were near?

2. How comely upon the mountains are the feet of the one bringing Good News, the one publishing peace, the one bringing Good News of something better, the one publishing salvation, the one saying to Zion; Your God has become king! (Isaiah 52:7)

[Question] How should the one telling out the Good News, that God has become king, be viewed by others?

3. I am creating the fruit of the lips. Continuous peace there will be to the one that is far away, and to the one that is near, Yehowah has said; And I will heal him. (Isaiah 57:19)

[Question] How did Yehowah God through Isaiah describe the preaching of the Good News of God's Kingdom through prophecy?

4. And he will exalt the horn of his people, the praise of all his loyal ones, of the sons of Israel, the people near to him. Praise Yah, you people! (Psalms 148:14)

[Question] How did the preaching of the Good News of God's Kingdom elevate the horn of the Jews, before all the world?

5. Consequently many gathered, so much so that there was no more room, not even about the door, and he began to speak the word to them. (Mark 2:2)

[Question] Who gathered to hear the preaching of the Good News through Jesus Christ?

6. For the promise is to you and to your children and to all those afar off, just as many as Yehowah our God may call to him. (Acts of Apostles 2:39)
