Ephesians 2:18~ Because through him we, both peoples, have the approach to the Father by one spirit.

Footnote: Or, in

1 Paul now shows, that both types of anointed Christians, now have approach to God, through just one spirit, the Holy Spirit, with which they have all been anointed.

[Question] Through what same thing, do both groups now have an approach to God?

2. For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for there is the same Lord over all, who is rich to all those calling upon him. (Romans 10:12)

[Question] What is there no longer any distinction between, for who alone do both peoples serve God under?

3. Consequently he is able also to save completely, those who are approaching God through him, because he is always alive to plead for them. (Hebrews 7:25)

[Question] Why is Jesus Christ able to completely save, those who approach God through him?

4. For truly by one spirit, we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink one spirit. (1 Corinthians 12:13)

[Question] How were all anointed Christians baptized into one body, and what one thing do they all drink?

Out of your dwelling places you should bring two loaves as a wave offering. Of two tenths of an ephah of fine flour they should prove to be. They should be baked leavened, as first ripe fruits to Yehowah. (Leviticus 23:17)

[Question] What offerings were made at the temple, that represented anointed Christians?

6. I am the door. Whoever enters through me, will be saved, and he will go in and out, and find pasturage. (John 10:9)

[Question] What is Jesus Christ like, for entry to Yehowah God, and what will those entering through him find?

7. Jesus said to him; I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. (John 14:6)

[Question] What is Jesus Christ to all those wanting to approach to God?

[Question] Will anyone ever get close to God, except through Jesus Christ?

8. Let us, therefore, approach with freeness of speech to the throne of undeserved kindness, that we may obtain mercy, and find undeserved kindness, for help at the right time. (Hebrews 4:16)

[Question] How should anointed sons of God approach to God, and what will they find there?
