

Ephesians 2:19~ Certainly, therefore, you are no longer strangers and alien residents, but you are fellow citizens of the holy ones, and are members of the household of God.

- 1· Certainly then anointed Gentile Christians are no longer strangers to the covenants of the promise, or like alien residents were in ancient Israel. They are now fellow citizens among all the group of holy anointed sons of God. They are all members now of the household of God, his spiritual sons, through the New Covenant.

[Question] What are Gentile anointed Christians not any longer?

[Question] What have they now become, through their faith?

- 2· That you were at that particular time without Christ, alienated from the state of Israel, and **strangers** to the covenants of the promise, and you had no hope, and were without **God** in the world. (**Ephesians 2:12**)

[Question] What was the situation of Gentile anointed Christians before becoming Christians?

- 3· In faith all these died, although they did not get the fulfillment of the promises, but they saw them afar off, and welcomed them, and publicly declared, that they were **strangers** and temporary **residents** in the land. (**Hebrews 11:13**)

[Question] What did all the men of faith mentioned in (**Hebrews Chapter 11**) not yet receive?

[Question] Therefore what did they all exercise regarding those promises of God?

- 4· As for us, our citizenship exists in the heavens, from which place also we are eagerly waiting for a savior, the Lord Jesus Christ. (**Philippians 3:20**)

[Question] Where does the citizenship of anointed Christians exist, and where will their salvation come from?

- 5· Thanking the Father, who rendered you suitable for your participation in the inheritance, of the **holy ones** in the light. (**Colossians 1:12**)

[Question] How should anointed sons of God feel, about being selected to participate in the inheritance of the Christ?

- 6· **I will even give to them in my house and within my walls a monument and a name, something better than sons and daughters. A name to time indefinite I shall give them, one that will not be cut off. (Isaiah 56:5)**

[Question] What did Yehowah God promise through Isaiah, to give even to eunuchs?

- 7· **But in case I am delayed, that you may know how you ought to conduct yourself in God's household, which is the congregation of the living God, a pillar and support of the truth. (1 Timothy 3:15)**

[Question] What is the congregation of God, in respect to the truth?

- 8· **But Christ was faithful as a Son over the house of that One. We are the house of that One, if we make fast our hold on our freeness of speech and our boasting over the hope firm to the end. (Hebrews 3:6)**

[Question] Who comprise the spiritual house of God today, and who is head over that house?

[Question] What must anointed ones do, to remain firm in their hope throughout their lives?

- 9· **Really, then, as long as we have time favorable for it, let us work what is good toward all, but especially toward those related to us in the faith. (Galatians 6:10)**

[Question] What should anointed Christians do, as long as they have time for it?
