

**Ephesians 2:21~ In union with him the whole building, being harmoniously joined together,<sup>1</sup> is growing into a holy temple<sup>2</sup> for Yehowah.<sup>3</sup>**

**1· This spiritual temple is growing as each new anointed Gentile member comes into the congregation of God through their spirit anointing. These spiritual stones, must fit together properly and harmoniously, according to God's plan, so as to grow into a complete temple for the worship of Yehowah God, where he will dwell by means of his Holy Spirit, and where all mankind will offer worship in the future.**

**[Question]** What is the condition of this temple today, and ever since the **First Century C.E.**?

**[Question]** How must these anointed stones fit together, to make a sound building, and according to whose plan?

**[Question]** Who dwells within this temple, and how?

**2· Whereas he is not holding fast to the head, to the one from whom all the body, being supplied and harmoniously joined together, by means of its joints and ligaments, goes on growing, with the growth, that God gives. (Colossians 2:19)**

**[Question]** What must all the members of the body hold soundly to, in order to grow?

**3· And you must say to him; This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Here is the man whose name is Sprout. And from his own place he will sprout, and he will certainly build the temple of Yehowah. (Zechariah 6:12)**

**[Question]** What would the man be called, who would come forth to build the temple of Yehowah God?

**4· Do you not know, that you people are God's temple, and that the spirit of God dwells in you? (1 Corinthians 3:16)**

**[Question]** What are all spirit anointed Christians, and what dwells within them all?

- 5· What! Do you not know, that the body of you people is the **temple** of the Holy Spirit within you, which you have from God? Also, you do not belong to yourselves. (**1 Corinthians 6:19**)

[Question] What dwells within all anointed Christians?

[Question] Since they have been repurchased by God through Christ, whom do they now belong to, and so who should they slave for alone?

- 6· As for the house, while it was **being** built, it was of quarry stone already completed that it was built, and as for hammers and axes or any tools of iron, they were not heard in the house while it was **being** built. (**1 Kings 6:7**)

[Question] How was the temple of Solomon built, and what was never heard at the site, where it was finally assembled?

- 7· Remain in union with me, and I in union with you. Just as the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it remains in the vine, in the same way, neither can you, unless you remain in union with me. (**John 15:4**)

[Question] Who must all anointed Christians remain in union with, to grow spiritually?

[Question] How is this action illustrated, through a grape vine?

- 8· You yourselves also as living stones, are **being** built up a spiritual house, for the purpose of a **holy** priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God, through Jesus Christ. (**1 Peter 2:5**)

[Question] What is the purpose of the building up of anointed Christians, and what do they offer up to God as a sacrifice?

- 9· The one that conquers, I will make him a pillar in the **temple** of my God, and he will by no means go out from it anymore, and I will write upon him the name of my God and the name of the city of my God, the New Jerusalem which descends out of heaven from my God, and that new name of mine. (**Revelation 3:12**)

[Question] What will the one that conquers become, within this temple structure, and where will a true support of the building never go thereafter?

**[Question]** Like the pillars in Solomon's temple, what will be written upon such conquerors?

**10<sup>11</sup>** And a reed like a rod was given me as he said; Get up and measure the **temple** sanctuary of God, and the altar and those worshiping in it. (**Revelation 11:1**)

**[Question]** What measuring does the anointed temple have to go through, and to what purpose?
