

**Ephesians 2:3~** Yes, among them we all at one time conducted ourselves in harmony with the desires of our flesh, doing the things willed by the flesh and the thoughts, and we were naturally children of wrath even as the rest.

- 1· Paul now includes himself in this foolish form of conduct, for he too was once in the world, and was governed over by these desires of the flesh. He then, did the things willed by his flesh, and thought the thoughts, that were governed over by the ruler of the authority of the air, Satan the Devil. Therefore he was a child of wrath, for God's wrath still rested upon him for his sinful actions and thoughts.

**[Question]** What foolish form of conduct, were all anointed Christians once engaged in, before coming to know Yehowah God?

**[Question]** What things then governed over them, and their thoughts?

**[Question]** What outlook then, did they all have?

- 2· And yet that is what some of you were. But you have been washed clean, but you have been sanctified, but you have been declared righteous in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, and with the spirit of our God. (**1 Corinthians 6:11**)

**[Question]** What kinds of things did anointed sons of God once do?

**[Question]** How has that all now changed for them, and through what force?

- 3· Keep on the watch and pray continually, that you may not enter into temptation. The spirit, of course, is eager, but the **flesh** is weak. (**Matthew 26:41**)

**[Question]** Why should anointed Christians pray continually?

**[Question]** What fight do they have constantly?

- 4· For the time that has passed by, is sufficient for you to have worked out the will of the nations, when you proceeded in deeds of loose conduct, lusts, excesses with wine, revelries, drinking matches, and illegal idolatries. (**1 Peter 4:3**)

**[Question]** What time, before becoming anointed Christians, should have been enough for them?

**[Question]** What kinds of conduct must anointed Christians leave completely behind them, as works of the past?

- 5· **He that exercises faith in the Son has everlasting life. He that disobeys the Son, will not see life, but the wrath of God remains upon him. (John 3:36)**

**[Question]** What does the one exercising faith in the Son Of Man have?

**[Question]** What though, remains upon those not exercising faith in the Son Of Man?

- 6· **And Aaron must lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over it all the errors of the sons of Israel, and all their revolts in all their sins, and he must put them upon the head of the goat, and send it away by the hand of a ready man into the wilderness. (Leviticus 16:21)**

**[Question]** What did the letting go of the second goat alive into the wilderness, say, about the further rebelliousness of the nation as a whole?

- 7· **Please, let your ear become attentive and your eyes opened, to listen to the prayer of your servant, which I am praying before you today, day and night, concerning the sons of Israel your servants, all the while making confession concerning the sins of the sons of Israel, with which we have sinned against you. We have sinned, both I and the house of my father. (Nehemiah 1:6)**

**[Question]** What did Nehemiah pray for Yehowah God to be attentive to, among his people who were repentant?

- 8· **Look! With error I was brought forth with birth pains, and in sin my mother conceived me. (Psalms 51:5)**

**[Question]** How did the Psalmist say, that he was brought forth from the womb?

- 9· **In those very things you, too, once walked, when you used to live in them. (Colossians 3:7)**

**[Question]** What things did anointed Christians once walk in, before becoming Christians?
