Ephesians 2:5~ Made us alive together with the Christ, even when we were dead in trespasses, by undeserved kindness you have been saved.

1. Thus God made us come to life through the life of his son, Jesus Christ. Even though, we were as good as dead in our trespasses, yet through his great undeserved kindness, he saved us, through the bath of the word, and through our faith in his word.

[Question] Through whom then, do anointed Christians come to life?
[Question] What would have happened to anointed Christians, if they remained in the state that they were in, before becoming anointed Christians?

2. Furthermore, though you were dead in your trespasses and in the uncircumcised state of your flesh, God made you alive together with him. He kindly forgave us all our trespasses (Colossians 2:13)

[Question] In what state were Christians in before becoming anointed ones of God?

3. Because the Law was given through Moses, the undeserved kindness and the truth, came to be through Jesus Christ. (John 1:17)

[Question] What things came through Moses, and what better things come through Christ?

4. Because this my son was dead, and came to life again. He was lost and was found. And they started to enjoy themselves. (Luke 15:24)

[Question] What did the father in the parable of the Prodigal son rejoice in?

5. For, indeed, Christ, while we were yet weak, died for ungodly men at the appointed time. (Romans 5:6)

[Question] Who did Christ die for, and in what condition were anointed Christians then in?

6' If, now, the spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he that raised up Christ Jesus from the dead, will also make your mortal bodies alive, through his spirit, that resides in you. (Romans 8:11)

[Question] What do anointed Christians, like Christ before them, have to look forward to?

7' Wherefore he says; Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and the Christ will shine upon you. (Ephesians 5:14)

[Question] What shines upon the hearts of anointed Christians, when awakening from the spiritual sleep of this old world under Satan the Devil's influence?

8. He saved us, and called us with a holy calling, not by reason of our works, but by reason of his own purpose and undeserved kindness. This was given us in connection with Christ Jesus before times long lasting. (2 Timothy 1:9)

[Question] By reason of what, are we saved?
