

Ephesians 2:8~ By this undeserved kindness, indeed, you have been saved through faith, and this not owing to you, it is God's gift.

- 1· Yes, by this great undeserved kindness, anointed Christians have been saved. Also it is not coming from anything within us that this has come, neither was it owed to us by God, it is a free gift. Truly appreciate it!

[Question] By what have anointed Christians been saved?

[Question] What is this undeserved kindness like?

- 2· On this account it was as a result of **faith**, that it might be according to undeserved **kindness**, in order for the promise to be sure to all his seed, not only to that which adheres to the Law, but also to that which adheres to the **faith** of Abraham. He is the father of us all. (**Romans 4:16**)

[Question] Why was undeserved kindness extended according to faith, and not according to works under the Law Covenant?

- 3· No man can come to me unless the Father, who sent me, draws him, and I will resurrect him in the last day. (**John 6:44**)

[Question] Who alone can approach to the Christ, and among those doing so, what can they expect after death?

- 4· However, as many as did receive him, to them he gave authority to become **God's** children, because they were exercising **faith** in his name. (**John 1:12**)

[Question] What are anointed ones given authority to become through spirit anointing, and why, also what alone have they done to obtain this undeserved kindness?

- 5· Immediately crying out, the father of the young child was saying; I **have faith**! Help me out where I need faith! (**Mark 9:24**)

[Question] What did the father of a young child cry out to Jesus Christ for?

- 6· But he said to the woman; Your **faith** has **saved** you, go your way in peace. (**Luke 7:50**)

[Question] What did Jesus Christ say to the woman, who washed his feet with her tears?

- 7· **Now the apostles said to the Lord; Give us more faith. (Luke 17:5)**

[Question] What did the apostles of Jesus Christ ask him for?

- 8· **In answer Jesus said to her; If you had known the free gift of God, and who it is that says to you; Give me a drink. You would have asked him, and he would have given you living water. (John 4:10)**

[Question] What was Jesus Christ prepared to offer to the woman at the well, if she had asked for it?

[Question] How is truth like living water?

- 9· **Further, because he was desiring to go across into Achaia, the brothers wrote the disciples, exhorting them to receive him kindly. So when he got there, he greatly helped those who had believed, on account of God's undeserved kindness. (Acts of Apostles 18:27)**

[Question] What did Apollos do to help those, who accepted God's undeserved kindness in Achaia?

- 10· **And it is as a free gift, that they are being declared righteous by his undeserved kindness, through the release by the ransom, paid by Christ Jesus. (Romans 3:24)**

[Question] What is God's undeserved kindness in providing the ransom like?

- 11· **Now if it is by undeserved kindness, it is no longer due to works, otherwise, the undeserved kindness no longer proves to be undeserved kindness. (Romans 11:6)**

[Question] Would it truly be undeserved kindness, if it was according to works of Law?

- 12· **All right! For their lack of faith they were broken off, but you are standing by faith. Quit having lofty ideas, but be in fear. (Romans 11:20)**

[Question] Why were Jewish branches of the garden olive broken off the tree?

[Question] How should Gentile branches feel now, in light of what?

- 13· For **through** the undeserved **kindness** given to me I tell everyone there among you not to think more of himself than it is necessary to think, but to think so as to **have** a sound mind, each one as God has distributed to him a measure of **faith**. (**Romans 12:3**)

[Question] How should each one of us think about himself, since God's mercy came to us through undeserved kindness, and not through works under the Law?

- 14· Because to you the privilege was given in behalf of Christ, not only to put your **faith** in him, but also to suffer in his behalf. (**Philippians 1:29**)

[Question] What privilege do anointed Christians have, and what goes along with it?

- 15· For you were buried with him in his baptism, and by relationship with him you were also raised up together **through** your **faith** in the operation of God, who raised him up from the dead. (**Colossians 2:12**)

[Question] What course of death and regeneration, does baptism set all of us upon?

- 16· He **saved** us and called us with a holy calling, not by reason of our works, but by reason of his own purpose and undeserved **kindness**. This was given us in connection with Christ Jesus, before times long lasting. (**2 Timothy 1:9**)

[Question] Why did Yehowah God save anointed Christians?

- 17· May the undeserved **kindness** of the Lord Jesus Christ be with the holy ones. (**Revelation 22:21**)

[Question] What did Paul pray for all his anointed brothers to have in full measure?
