

Ephesians 2:9~ No, it is not owing to works, in order, that no man should have ground for boasting.

- 1· Therefore it is not owing to works, and this was done, so that no man might have any grounds for boasting over himself, which is something God hates. We are all born into sin, and only through God undeserved kindness, have we been saved.

[Question] Why does salvation come through undeserved kindness only?

- 2· May the undeserved kindness of the Lord Jesus Christ be with the holy ones. (**Revelation 22:21**)

[Question] What did Paul always ask his God to give to anointed Christians?

- 3· You behold, that his faith worked along with his **works**, and by his **works**, his faith was perfected. (**James 2:22**)

[Question] What though, must we show after this, to prove to God, that we have entered onto a course of righteousness before him?

- 4· In **order**, that no flesh might boast in the sight of God. (**1 Corinthians 1:29**)

[Question] What does Yehowah God not want any man to be doing before him?

- 5· Where, then, is the **boasting**? It is shut out. Through what Law? That of **works**? No indeed, but through the Law of faith. (**Romans 3:27**)

[Question] How then, does God shut out the boasting of all men?

- 6· Now if it is by undeserved kindness, it is no longer due to **works**, otherwise, the undeserved kindness no longer proves to be undeserved kindness. (**Romans 11:6**)

[Question] Do we gain this approach to God through undeserved kindness, or through works under the Law Covenant?
