

**Ephesians 3:12~** By means of whom we have this freeness of speech and an approach with confidence through our faith in him.

- 1· Thus through Jesus Christ, we anointed Christians have a special freeness of speech, and an approach to God with confidence, through our faith in him.

**[Question]** What do anointed Christians have toward God and Christ through their anointing with Holy Spirit?

- 2· Jesus said to him; I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except **through** me. (**John 14:6**)

**[Question]** What is Jesus Christ in relation to the father Yehowah God?

**[Question]** Will anyone approach to Yehowah God, without going through his Christ?

- 3· Through whom also, we **have** gained our **approach** by **faith**, into this undeserved kindness in which we now stand, and let us exult, based on hope of the glory of God. (**Romans 5:2**)

**[Question]** What closeness to God have anointed Christians gained, and how?

- 4· Let us, therefore, **approach** with **freeness** of **speech** to the throne of undeserved kindness, that we may obtain mercy and find undeserved kindness for help at the right time. (**Hebrews 4:16**)

**[Question]** What kind of an approach do anointed Christians have to God, and what can they expect to find with him?

- 5· Now **through** the Christ we **have** this sort of **confidence** toward God. (**2 Corinthians 3:4**)

**[Question]** What confidence does the spirit of anointing give to anointed Christians?
