Ephesians 3:19~ And to know the love of the Christ, which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all¹ the fullness that God gives.

Footnote: Or, may be filled up to all

1. Paul wants them all to know the love of the Christ, through his spirit, which surpasses all the enjoyments of knowledge, and which anointed Christians can feel through prayer. He wants them to be possessed of all the fullness of God, through his spirit.

[Question] What did Paul want for them to be partakers of, through the spirit within them?

[Question] What is this love of the Christ better than, and when primarily do they feel it?

2. Who will separate us from the love of the Christ? Will tribulation or distress or persecution or hunger or nakedness or danger or sword? (Romans 8:35)

[Question] What things did Paul state were unable to separate them from the love of the Christ?

3. For we all received from out of his fullness, even undeserved kindness upon undeserved kindness. (John 1:16)

[Question] What have all anointed Christians received out of Christ's fullness?

4. Because it is in him that all the fullness of the divine quality dwells bodily. (Colossians 2:9)

[Question] Where does all the fullness of Yehowah God dwell bodily?

5. That in everything you have been enriched in him, in full ability to speak and in full knowledge. (1 Corinthians 1:5)

[Question] What riches will come to anointed sons through the Holy Spirit within them?

5. Now concerning foods offered to idols. We know we all have knowledge. Knowledge puffs up, but love builds up. (1 Corinthians 8:1)

[Question] What does knowledge tend to do, to those possessing it?
