

**Ephesians 3:20~** Now to the one who can, according to his power which is operating in us, do more than superabundantly beyond all the things we ask or conceive.

- 1• Paul now prays to Yehowah, to effect such things in their behalf. Yehowah God is the one who through his spirit of holiness, and the power that operates through that spirit, can do more than superabundantly beyond anything we might ever ask of him, or even conceive that he can do. His spirit is exquisite, and there is nothing it cannot do!

**[Question]** How can Yehowah God act in our behalf through his Holy Spirit?

**[Question]** What is his Holy Spirit like, and what can it do?

- 2• To this end I am indeed working hard, exerting myself in accordance with the operation of him, and which is at work in me, with power. (**Colossians 1:29**)

**[Question]** What was Paul working hard along with, that was within him?

- 3• This is why I tell you, all the **things** you pray and **ask** for have faith, that you have practically received, and you will have them. (**Mark 11:24**)

**[Question]** How should anointed Christians feel about all the things that they have asked God for, according to his will?

- 4• But just as it is written: Eye has not seen and ear has not heard, neither have there been conceived in the heart of man, the **things** that God has prepared, for those who love him. (**1 Corinthians 2:9**)

**[Question]** What has the mind of mankind not yet even been able to conceive about Yehowah God, and his glorious riches that await them?

- 5• And also what you have not requested, I will give you, both riches and glory, so that there will not have happened to be any among the kings like you, all your days. (**1 Kings 3:13**)

**[Question]** What did Yehowah God give to Solomon, that he did not ask for?

- 6• As though this should be something little in your eyes, O

**God, yet you speak concerning the house of your servant down to a distant future time, and you have looked on me according to the opportunity of the man in the ascendancy, O Yehowah God. (1 Chronicles 17:17)**

**[Question]** How did King David feel when before his God?

- 7· The wisdom and the knowledge are being given you, also wealth and riches and honor I shall give you, such as no kings that were prior to you happened to have, and such as no one after you, will come to have. (2 Chronicles 1:12)**

**[Question]** What was given to Solomon, because he asked Yehowah God for wisdom to guide God's people?

- 8· Your God has laid command upon your strength. Do show strength, O God, you who have acted for us. (Psalms 68:28)**

**[Question]** Whom did the Psalmist say acted, and showed his strength in behalf of his people?

- 9· Now to him who can make you firm in accord with the Good News I declare, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the sacred secret, which has been kept in silence for long-lasting times (Romans 16:25)**

**[Question]** The Good News of God was what for a long time, and where was it hidden?

- 10· If anyone speaks, let him speak as it were the sacred pronouncements of God. If anyone ministers, let him minister as dependent on the strength that God supplies, so that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ. The glory and the might are his forever and ever. Amen. (1 Peter 4:11)**

**[Question]** What things should anointed Christian ministers speak, and who should they depend upon in all things?
