

Ephesians 3:4~ In the face of this you, when you read this, can realize the comprehension I have in the sacred secret of the Christ.

- 1· That being the case, Paul now reasons, that they should be able to realize the depth of the comprehension, that he has in the sacred secret of Christ, for he received it directly from Christ through a revelation.

[Question] What does he now show is the depth of his own understanding relative to theirs?

- 2· But even if I am unskilled in speech, I certainly am not in knowledge, but in every way we manifested it to you in all things. (**2 Corinthians 11:6**)

[Question] What was Paul evidently not very skilled at, but why was it beneficial to listen to him anyway?

- 3· Let a man so appraise us as being subordinates of **Christ**, and stewards of **sacred secrets** of God. (**1 Corinthians 4:1**)

[Question] How should others view all anointed Christians?

- 4· Also for me, that ability to speak may be given me, with the opening of my mouth, with freeness of speech to make known the **sacred secret** of the Good News. (**Ephesians 6:19**)

[Question] What did Paul ask his brothers to pray for him to be able to do, whenever the need arose?

- 5· This **sacred secret** is great. Now I am speaking with respect to **Christ** and the congregation. (**Ephesians 5:32**)

[Question] What sacred secret is great, and who does it apply to?
