Ephesians 3:7~ I became a minister of this according to the free gift of the undeserved kindness of God that was given me according to the way his power operates.

1. Paul now shows, that he became a minister of this, according to the undeserved kindness of God, that was given to him, by God, through his power.

[Question] What work of distributing this undeserved kindness from God, is Paul now engaged in?

2. Or a ministry, let us be at this ministry, or he that teaches, let him be at his teaching. (Romans 12:7)

[Question] How should one who has been given a ministry treat it, or a gift of teaching?

3. I became a minister of this congregation, in accordance with the stewardship from God, which was given me in your interest, to preach the word of God fully. (Colossians 1:25)

[Question] What stewardship was Paul appointed to, and in whose behalf?

4. However, I am writing you the more outspokenly on some points, as if reminding you again, because of the undeserved kindness given to me from God. (Romans 15:15)

[Question] Why did Paul continually remind others, of the undeserved kindness of God?

5. As they were publicly ministering to Yehowah and fasting, the Holy Spirit said; Of all persons set Barnabas and Saul apart for me, for the work, to which I have called them.

(Acts of Apostles 13:2)

[Question] What work did the Holy Spirit designate, both Paul and Barnabus to?

6 Paul selected Silas and went off, after he had been entrusted by the brothers to the undeserved kindness of Yehowah. (Acts of Apostles 15:40)

[Question] What did the brothers sending Paul and Silas out to preach, entrust to them?

7. Since, then, we have gifts differing according to the undeserved kindness given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy, according to the faith proportioned to us. (Romans 12:6)

[Question] What gifts differ among anointed Christians, and how should we use these many gifts?

8. Thanks be to God, for his indescribable free gift. (2 Corinthians 9:15)

[Question] What did Paul find mere words, inadequate to describe?

9. But when God, who separated me from my mother's womb and called me through his undeserved kindness, thought good. (Galatians 1:15)

[Question] Who separated Paul from his mother's womb, and called him to the preaching of the Good News of God's Kingdom?

10" For which I was appointed a preacher and apostle and teacher. (2 Timothy 1:11)

[Question] What appointment did Paul receive, and from whom?

11. For it is impossible as regards those who have once for all been enlightened, and who have tasted the heavenly free gift, and who have become partakers of Holy Spirit. (Hebrews 6:4)

[Question] What is it impossible for those who have been anointed, and yet fallen away, to revive again within themselves?
