Ephesians 4:1~ I, therefore, the prisoner in the Lord, entreat you to walk worthily of the calling with which you were called.

Paul now encourages all the anointed Christians there in Ephesus to walk in a way, that is worthy of the one who called them to everlasting life and glory. Their lives must be holy, like the spirit within them, and they must win the war against the desires of the flesh, and put them to death, like Christ did, through their love of the Holy Spirit.

2. For which I am acting as an ambassador in chains, that I may speak in connection with it with boldness, as I ought to speak. (Ephesians 6:20)

I am exhorting you rather on the basis of love, seeing that I am such as I am, Paul an aged man, yes, now also a prisoner for the sake of Christ Jesus. (Philemon 1:9)

[Question] How did Paul entreat Philemon in his own old age?

4. Only behave in a manner worthy of the Good News about the Christ, in order, that, whether I come and see you or be absent, I may hear about the things which concern you, that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one soul striving side by side for the faith of the Good News.

(Philippians 1:27)

[Question] How did Paul want anointed Christians to behave, respecting the Good News, whether he was present of absent?

[Question] How should they act as one body toward the Good News of God?

5' Moreover, those whom he foreordained are the ones he also called. Those whom he called are the ones he also declared to be righteous. Finally those whom he declared righteous are the ones he also glorified. (Romans 8:30)

[Question] How does one come to be called by God, to be an anointed one?

6. In whatever state each one was called, let him remain in it. (1 Corinthians 7:20)

[Question] What state should anointed Christians remain in, once they are anointed?

7. On account of this I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus in behalf of you, the people of the nations. (Ephesians 3:1)

[Question] For whose sake did Paul serve as a prisoner of the Romans?

8. In order to walk worthily of Yehowah to the end of fully pleasing him, as you go on bearing fruit in every good work, and increasing in the accurate knowledge of God. (Colossians 1:10)

[Question] What was the aim of holy anointed sons of God respecting their father, Yehowah God?

[Question] What works should they keep on doing, and what should they always go on increasing in?

9. To the end that you should go on walking worthily of God, who is calling you to his kingdom and glory. (1
Thessalonians 2:12)

[Question] What way should anointed Christians go on walking, and why?

10. Paul, a prisoner for the sake of Christ Jesus, and Timothy, our brother, to Philemon, our beloved one and fellow worker. (Philemon 1:1)

[Question] What was Paul imprisoned for being?

11. Nevertheless, you do have a few names in Sardis, that did not defile their outer garments, and they shall walk with me in white ones, because they are worthy. (Revelation 3:4)

[Question] What was the condition of only a few there in Sardis?
