

Ephesians 4:13~ Until we all attain to the oneness in the faith, and in the accurate knowledge of the Son of God, to a full-grown man, to the measure of stature, that belongs to the fullness of the Christ.

1• These gifts will all be given, until they all as a spiritual body attain to the oneness in the faith, and unity of belief through accurate knowledge of the Son of God. They must all become full grown spiritual men, men of the same stature that belongs to the fullness of the Christ himself. We must all become as mature as Christ is. Thus **these gifts would not stop** until all attained to the stature of the Christ, within this body.

[Question] How long will these spiritual gifts be given, until what is reached?

[Question] What degree of maturity must all within the congregation attain to?

[Question] What then, would not stop until this maturity was reached?

2• Does this sound like the Christianity you know and practice? If not, then what is wrong today, and why are these gifts being withheld by Yehowah God and his Christ, and why are there thousands of different sects within Christendom, all of whom who are in disagreement with one another?

[Question] What pointed qualities must we all ask today, and in light of what?

[Question] What is the condition of Christianity today, and why has Yehowah God withheld these spiritual gifts from Christians?

3• Brothers, do not become young children in powers of understanding, but be babes as to badness. Yet become **full-grown** in powers of understanding. (**1 Corinthians 14:20**)

[Question] What should we seek to become mature in?

4• He is the one we are publicizing, admonishing every **man** and teaching every **man** in all wisdom, that we may present every **man** complete in union with **Christ**. (**Colossians 1:28**)

[Question] What is the purpose of all admonishing and teaching, through the congregation?

- 5· This means everlasting life, their taking in **knowledge** of you, the only true **God**, and of the one whom you sent forth, Jesus **Christ**. (**John 17:3**)

[Question] What is necessary for one to gain everlasting life?

- 6· Now we speak wisdom among those who are mature, but not the wisdom of this system of things, nor that of the rulers of this system of things, who are to come to nothing. (**1 Corinthians 2:6**)

[Question] What wisdom do anointed overseers speak to the congregation?

[Question] What is to come to the wisdom of the world around us?

- 7· When I was a babe, I used to speak as a babe, to think as a babe, to reason as a babe. Now that I have become a **man**, I have done away with the traits of a babe. (**1 Corinthians 13:11**)

[Question] What traits of a babe, does every man put away, when becoming mature?

- 8· Why, for that matter, I do indeed also consider all things to be loss, on account of the excelling value of the **knowledge** of **Christ** Jesus, my Lord. On account of him, I have taken the loss of all things, and I consider them as a lot of refuse, that I may gain **Christ**. (**Philippians 3:8**)

[Question] What did Paul consider all material things to be, when compared to the excelling value of the Christ?

- 9· For this reason, now that we have left the primary doctrine about the **Christ**, let us press on to maturity, not laying a foundation again, namely, repentance from dead works, and **faith** toward **God**. (**Hebrews 6:1**)

[Question] What should anointed Christians do, after getting the basics of Christianity firmly fixed in mind?

[Question] What are some of the elementary teachings of the Good News of God?

- 10· But let endurance have its work complete, that you may be complete and sound in all respects, not lacking in anything. (**James 1:4**)

[Question] What work should we let have its way within us, for what will this make us before our God?

- 11· Do not be afraid of the things you are about to suffer. Look! The Devil will keep on throwing some of you into prison, that you may be fully put to the test, and that you may have tribulation ten days. Prove yourself faithful even to death, and I will give you the crown of life. (Revelation 2:10)**

[Question] What should anointed Christians not be afraid to suffer?

[Question] What will Satan the Devil keep doing to anointed Christians throughout their lives?
