Ephesians 4:14~ In order, that we should no longer be babes, tossed about as by waves and carried hither and thither by every wind of teaching by means of the trickery of men, by means of cunning in contriving error.

1. These spiritual gifts are given, so that we might not remain babes spiritually, persons tossed about by every wind of teaching, like waves of the sea carried this way and that, to no purpose, and accomplishing nothing. Rather, we should carry on as spirit directed men of purpose, and accomplish God's will for us to his glory.

[Question] Why are these spiritual gifts given to each anointed one?

[Question] How could we illustrate, how ineffectual we would become without them?

[Question] What then, should we allow to direct us, in every affair of life?

2. We live within Satan the Devil's world, and he uses every means of trickery to defeat us. He does not care what we do, as long as we do not do, the will of Yehowah God. Therefore he is cunning in his means of contriving error, to catch uneducated, ignorant and unwary Christians. Beware of this roaring lion!

[Question] Where are anointed Christians living, and who is their adversary?

[Question] What is Satan the Devil's mindset regarding true anointed sons of God?

[Question] Why then is a broad spectrum of accurate knowledge essential to attaining our goals?

3. Keep your senses, be watchful. Your adversary, the Devil, walks about like a roaring lion, seeking to devour someone. (1 Peter 5:8)

[Question] What is Satan the Devil like, and how does a lion scare its prey?

4. This hope we have as an anchor for the soul, both sure and firm, and it enters in within the curtain. (Hebrews 6:19)

[Question] Where does our hope allow us to enter in, and how confident can we be in this hope, through the Holy Spirit?

5. But let him keep on asking in faith, not doubting at all, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven by the wind and blown about. (James 1:6)

[Question] What should the man of faith not have within him, over the things he asks God for?

6. Let no man deprive you of the prize who takes delight in a mock humility, and a form of worship of the angels, taking his stand on the things he has seen, puffed up without proper cause by his fleshly frame of mind. (Colossians 2:18)

[Question] Whom should we be on guard against, for who are such ones really worshipping?

7. Do not be carried away with various and strange teachings, for it is fine for the heart to be given firmness by undeserved kindness, not by eatables, by which those who occupy themselves with them have not been benefited. (Hebrews 13:9)

[Question] What should we not allow ourselves to be carried away by, for what gives the heart firmness?

8 Accordingly, put away all badness and all deceitfulness and hypocrisy and envies, and all sorts of backbiting. (1 Peter 2:1)

[Question] What things should we put completely away from us?

9. For such men are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into apostles of Christ. (2 Corinthians 11:13)

[Question] What are such men, and why should we avoid them?

10" You have tossed away all those straying from your regulations, for their trickiness is falsehood. (Psalms 119:118)

[Question] What does Yehowah do, toward all those straying from his regulations?

11. O Yehowah, do deliver my soul from false lips, from the tricky tongue. (Psalms 120:2)

[Question] What did the Psalmist ask his God to deliver him from?

12. Like foxes in the devastated places are what your own prophets have become, O Israel. (Ezekiel 13:4)

[Question] What did the prophets of Israel become like, when Yehowah closed off his understanding from them?

13' What, then, did you go out to see? A man dressed in soft garments? Why, those wearing soft garments are in the houses of kings. (Matthew 11:8)

[Question] What question did Jesus Christ put to his disciples, who went out to see John the Baptist?

14. For you were bought with a price. By all means, glorify God in the body of you people. (1 Corinthians 6:20)

[Question] What should anointed Christians now do, because we have been repurchased by God through Christ?

15. Brothers, do not become young children in powers of understanding, but be babes as to badness, yet become full-grown in powers of understanding. (1 Corinthians 14:20)

[Question] What should we try to become mature in?

16. For everyone that partakes of milk is unacquainted with the word of righteousness, for he is a babe. (Hebrews 5:13)

[Question] What does everyone partaking of milk, not know?

17. You, therefore, beloved ones, having this advance knowledge, be on your guard, that you may not be led away with them by the error of the Law-defying people, and fall from your own steadfastness. (2 Peter 3:17)

[Question] What should those who have advanced knowledge, be on guard against constantly, and why?

18. These are the rocks hidden below water in your love feasts, while they feast with you, shepherds that feed themselves without fear, waterless clouds carried this way and that by winds, trees in late autumn, but fruitless, having died twice, having been uprooted. (Jude 1:12)

[Question] How would these deceivers come, and enter into the congregation of anointed ones?

19. After this I saw four angels standing upon the four corners of the earth, holding tight the four winds of the earth, that no wind might blow upon the earth or upon the sea or upon any tree. (Revelation 7:1)

[Question] What sealing work must be brought to completion, before the great tribulation starts?

20" And no wonder, for Satan himself keeps transforming himself into an angel of light. (2 Corinthians 11:14)

[Question] What does Satan the Devil keep transforming himself into to deceive mankind, and what type of organization does he operate through primarily?
