Ephesians 4:21~ Provided, indeed, that you heard him and were taught by means of him, just as truth is in Jesus.

1. Paul now refers to those who actually knew Christ, as not being like this. Paul was one of those ones, and he knew that Jesus was about the truth, the truth about God.

[Question] What did Paul himself bear witness to, that Christ was like, for he himself had seen Christ's glory?

2. Finally, brothers, we request you and exhort you by the Lord Jesus, just as you received the instruction from us on how you ought to walk and please God, just as you are in fact walking, that you would keep on doing it more fully. (1 Thessalonians 4:1)

[Question] What way were the Thessalonians encouraged to keep walking in even more?

3. So the Word became flesh and resided among us, and we had a view of his glory, a glory such as belongs to an only-begotten son from a father, and he was full of undeserved kindness and truth. (John 1:14)

[Question] What kind of a glory did Jesus Christ display to his disciples, and what was he full of?

4. Jesus said to him; I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. (John 14:6)

[Question] Who is the way, and the truth, and the life?[Question] Whom must allow men go through, to approach to God?

5. Therefore Pilate said to him; Well, then, are you a king? Jesus answered; You yourself are saying that I am a king. For this I have been born, and for this I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone that is on the side of the truth listens to my voice. (John 18:37)
