Ephesians 4:25~ Wherefore, now that you have put away falsehood, speak truth each one of you with his neighbor, because we are members belonging to one another.

1. So now that anointed Christians have put away falsehood, or lying, speak truth each one of you with his neighbor. Why? Because we are all members within a larger body, thus we belong to one another.

[Question] What should anointed Christians speak to one another, and to all always, and why?

2. Does the body lie to itself? Does it try to trick other parts of the body? Does the mind say to the hand, go ahead and stick your hand in that saw blade, or into a raging fire, saying; It will not bother you? No! The body possesses an inherent honesty and integrity, and caring for all its members, and we must also.

[Question] What must we ask ourselves about the human body, and how might we illustrate this honesty within the body?

3. And secretly held back some of the price, his wife also knowing about it, and he brought just a part, and deposited it at the feet of the apostles. (Acts of Apostles 5:2)

[Question] How did Ananias and Sapphira try to fool God, through his spirit?

4. But now really put them all away from you, wrath, anger, badness, abusive speech, and obscene talk out of your mouth. (Colossians 3:8)

[Question] What things should we put completely away from us?

5. These are the things that you people should do. Speak truthfully with one another. With truth and the judgment of peace, do your judging in your gates. (Zechariah 8:16)

[Question] How did Zechariah say, that God's people should speak and judge one another?

6. Do not be lying to one another. Strip off the old personality with its practices. (Colossians 3:9)

[Question] What should anointed Christians, not be doing to one another?

[Question] What personality should they strip off completely?

7. But as for the cowards and those without faith, and those who are disgusting in their filth, and murderers and fornicators, and those practicing spiritism, and idolaters, and all the liars, their portion, will be in the lake that burns with fire and sulphur. This means the second death. (Revelation 21:8)

[Question] Who will end up in the Lake of Fire, and what does that Lake represent?

8. So we, although many, are one body in union with Christ, but members belonging individually to one another. (Romans 12:5)

[Question] What are the individual members of the anointed Christian congregation, collectively?

9. You are to keep far from a false word. And do not kill the innocent and the righteous, for I shall not declare the wicked one righteous. (Exodus 23:7)

[Question] What were Israelites to keep far from?

[Question] Who were they commanded, not to kill off, through wicked judgments?

10. Or he does find something lost, and is actually deceptive about it, and does swear falsely over any of all the things, that the man might do to sin by them. (Leviticus 6:3)

[Question] What kind of deceptive behavior was condemned?

11. You people must not steal, and you must not deceive, and you must not deal falsely anyone with his associate. (Leviticus 19:11)

[Question] What things relating to stealing were also condemned?

12. So that there should be no division in the body, but that its members, should have the same care for one another. (1 Corinthians 12:25)

[Question] What should there be no division within?

[Question] How should the different members of the body, treat one another?

13. To this he said; All is well. My master himself has sent me, saying; Look! Just now there have come to me two young men from the mountainous region of Ephraim from the sons of the prophets. Do give them, please, a talent of silver and two changes of garments. (2 Kings 5:22)

[Question] How did Gehazi deceive Naaman concerning gifts he offered to Elisha?

14. He who is walking faultlessly and practicing righteousness and speaking the truth in his heart. (Psalms 15:2)

[Question] Who will draw close to Yehowah God through his spirit?

15. Remove from me even the false way, and favor me with your own Law. (Psalms 119:29)

[Question] What did the Psalmist ask Yehowah God to remove far from him?

16. Falsehood I have hated, and I do keep detesting it. Your Law I have loved. (Psalms 119:163)

[Question] What did the Psalmist hate just as Yehowah hates it?

17. It is the lip of truth that will be firmly established forever, but the tongue of falsehood will be only as long as a moment. (Proverbs 12:19)

[Question] What will be firmly established forever, and what will last only for a moment?

18. A false word is what the righteous hates, but the wicked ones act shamefully, and cause disgrace for themselves. (Proverbs 13:5)

[Question] What word does the righteous one hate?

19. Do not become a witness against your fellowman without grounds. Then you would have to be foolish with your lips. (Proverbs 24:28)

[Question] What are we counseled not to become?

20. An able-bodied man that is flattering his companion, is spreading out a mere net for his steps. (Proverbs 29:5)

[Question] What is flattery like spreading out a net for?

21. For then I shall give to peoples the change to a pure language, in order for them all to call upon the name of Yehowah, in order to serve him shoulder to shoulder. (Zephaniah 3:9)

[Question] What did Yehowah God promise to give to his people, and then how would they come to serve him?

22. As regards the remaining ones of Israel, they will do no unrighteousness, nor speak a lie, nor will there be found in their mouths a tricky tongue, for they themselves will feed and actually lie stretched out, and there will be no one making them tremble. (Zephaniah 3:13)

[Question] What did Yehowah God promise, would come to be the case with his people?

23. But Peter said; Ananias, why has Satan emboldened you to play false to the Holy Spirit, and to hold back secretly some of the price of the field? (Acts of Apostles 5:3)

[Question] What did Ananias do, to try to deceive his brothers in spirit?

24. If the foot should say; Because I am not a hand, I am no part of the body, it is not for this reason, no part of the body. (1 Corinthians 12:15)

[Question] Would any part of the body, not actually be a part of the body, just because it wanted to be such?
