

Ephesians 4:3~ Earnestly endeavoring to observe the oneness of the spirit in the uniting bond of peace.

- 1· **Their lives should be one continuous exercise of being joined together in their love of the Holy Spirit, in the uniting bond of peace, for true Christians are at peace with God and this peace, which comes through his spirit is overwhelming, like a placid lake perfectly reflecting distant mountains in its still waters, it is so very desirable. If all the members of the congregation have it, then they will think and act, as one person in Christ.**

[Question] If all the members of the congregation act like this peace, then what will the entire congregation operate like?

- 2· **That with one accord you may with one mouth glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. (Romans 15:6)**

[Question] How should the different members of the congregation glorify God?

- 3· **Now I exhort you, brothers, through the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you should all speak in agreement, and that there should not be divisions among you, but that you may be fitly united in the same mind, and in the same line of thought. (1 Corinthians 1:10)**

[Question] What should all members of the congregation speak regarding the Good News of God?

[Question] How can a congregation reach such consensus, and what must they all be to attain to this united way of thinking?

- 4· **Only behave in a manner worthy of the Good News about the Christ, in order, that, whether I come and see you or be absent, I may hear about the things which concern you, that you are standing firm in one **spirit**, with one soul striving side by side for the faith of the Good News. (Philippians 1:27)**

[Question] What way should they all behave, and why?

- 5· **Also, let the **peace** of the Christ control in your hearts, for you were, in fact, called to it in one body. And show**

yourselves thankful. (Colossians 3:15)

[Question] What should control in their hearts, seeing that they are one body?

[Question] What should they always express to God, the giver of every good gift?

6· But he who is joined to the Lord is one spirit. (1 Corinthians 6:17)

[Question] What is anyone who is joined to the Christ?
