

**Ephesians 4:32~ But become kind to one another, tenderly compassionate, freely forgiving one another just as God also by Christ freely forgave you.**

- 1• **Rather Christians should become kind to one another, they should be tenderly compassionate, for we have all experienced tribulation and stress. We should freely forgive one another over anything, that we might have a reason to forgive others, thus acting like our heavenly father, who freely forgave us through Christ, for all our trespasses against him which are many more.**

**[Question]** How should anointed Christians behave toward one another when under tribulation and stress?

**[Question]** How should we feel if another wrongs us, and what should the first avenue of resolution be, and why?

- 2• **He has told you, O earthling man, what is good. And what is Yehowah asking back from you, but to exercise justice, and to love kindness, and to be modest in walking with your God? (Micah 6:8)**

**[Question]** What are the simple requirements of Yehowah our God?

- 3• **By purity, by knowledge, by long-suffering, by kindness, by Holy Spirit, by love free from hypocrisy. (2 Corinthians 6:6)**

**[Question]** Through what things, do anointed Christians recommend themselves to others?

- 4• **Accordingly, as God's chosen ones, holy and loved, clothe yourselves with the tender affections of compassion, kindness, lowliness of mind, mildness, and long-suffering. (Colossians 3:12)**

**[Question]** What should God's holy anointed sons clothe themselves with?

- 5• **Finally, all of you be like-minded, showing fellow feeling, having brotherly affection, tenderly compassionate, humble in mind. (1 Peter 3:8)**

**[Question]** What did Peter say, that we should treat one another, and view ourselves?

- 6• **For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly**

**Father will also forgive you. (Matthew 6:14)**

**[Question]** What will Yehowah forgive us, if we forgive others?

- 7· In like manner my heavenly Father will also deal with you, if you do not forgive each one his brother, from your hearts. (Matthew 18:35)**

**[Question]** How will Yehowah deal with us, if we do not learn to forgive one another?

- 8· And when you stand praying, forgive whatever you have against anyone, in order, that your Father who is in the heavens may also forgive you, your trespasses. (Mark 11:25)**

**[Question]** How should we approach to Yehowah God, doing what first?

- 9· Anything you kindly forgive anyone, I do too. In fact, as for me, whatever I have kindly forgiven, if I have kindly forgiven anything, it has been for your sakes in Christ's sight. (2 Corinthians 2:10)**

**[Question]** How did Paul feel personally, about what others were able to forgive one another?

**[Question]** Why did he himself practice forgiving others?

- 10· This is what you are to say to Joseph; I beseech you, pardon, please, the revolt of your brothers and their sin, in that they have rendered evil to you. And now, pardon please, the revolt of the servants of your father's God. And Joseph burst into tears, when they spoke to him. (Genesis 50:17)**

**[Question]** How did Joseph's brothers through a guilty conscience approach Joseph?

**[Question]** What though, was his mindset?

- 11· Preserving loving-kindness for thousands, pardoning error and transgression and sin, but by no means will he give exemption from punishment, bringing punishment for the error of fathers upon sons and upon grandsons, upon the third generation and upon the fourth generation. (Exodus 34:7)**

**[Question]** What kind of a loyal God is Yehowah God?

**[Question]** Yet what will he not exempt anyone from?

- 12· He has flashed up in the darkness as a light to the upright ones. He is gracious and merciful and righteous. (Psalms 112:4)**

**[Question]** What has Yehowah become for the righteous ones of the earth, for what kind of a God is he?

- 13· The insight of a man certainly slows down his anger, and it is beauty on his part, to pass over transgression. (Proverbs 19:11)**

**[Question]** What slows down the anger of a man, and what is it a beauty for him to pass over in another?

- 14· It is a glory for a man to desist from disputing, but everyone foolish will burst out in it. (Proverbs 20:3)**

**[Question]** What is it a glory for a man to desist from?

- 15· Jesus said to him; I say to you, not, up to seven times, but, up to seventy-seven times. (Matthew 18:22)**

**[Question]** How often must we forgive a brother, who repents and comes back asking our forgiveness repeatedly?

- 16· He said; The one that acted mercifully toward him. Jesus then said to him; Go your way and be doing the same yourself. (Luke 10:37)**

**[Question]** With what should we go looking for our neighbors?

- 17· And forgive us our sins, for we ourselves also forgive everyone that is in debt to us, and do not bring us into temptation. (Luke 11:4)**

**[Question]** What should we forgive, if we want similar things to be forgiven by God within us?

- 18· Or he that exhorts, let him be at his exhortation. He that distributes, let him do it with liberality. He that presides, let him do it in real earnest. He that shows mercy, let him do it with cheerfulness. (Romans 12:8)**

**[Question]** How should those assigned to responsibilities, through gifts of the spirit within the congregation, go about using them?

- 19· Love is long-suffering and **kind**. Love is not jealous, it does not brag, does not get puffed up. (**1 Corinthians 13:4**)

**[Question]** What are some of the fine qualities of principled love?

- 20· Does not behave indecently, does not look for its own interests, does not become provoked. It does not keep account of the injury. (**1 Corinthians 13:5**)

**[Question]** What things does love not keep track of, or look out for?

- 21· Continue putting up with one another and **forgiving** one another **freely** if anyone has a cause for complaint against another. Even as Yehowah **freely forgave** you, so do you also. (**Colossians 3:13**)

**[Question]** How should we feel, even if we have a cause for complaint against one another, and why?

- 22· However, when the kindness and the love for man on the part of our Savior, **God**, was manifested. (**Titus 3:4**)

**[Question]** What kindness has been made manifest before anointed Christians?
