Ephesians 4:5~ One Lord, one faith, one baptism.

1. Paul carries his argument even further saying; That there is One Lord, Jesus Christ, one faith, to which they were all called, and one Baptism, denoting repentance and seeking forgiveness of sins from God. Here also there is no ground for divisions.

[Question] What things are there only one of, and what should this lead to for anointed Christians?

2. There is actually to us one God the Father, out of whom all things are, and we for him. There is one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom all things are, and we through him. (1 Corinthians 8:6)

[Question] What is there only one of for anointed Christians?

3. And there are varieties of ministries, and yet there is the same Lord. (1 Corinthians 12:5)

[Question] What are there varieties of, within the Christian congregation, yet all under the same Lord?

4. Now because we have the same spirit of faith as that of which it is written: I exercised faith, therefore I spoke, we too exercise faith and therefore we speak. (2 Corinthians 4:13)

[Question] What spirit of faith do anointed Christians have, and what does it impel them to do, through faith?

5. For truly by one spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink one spirit. (1 Corinthians 12:13)

[Question] What are all anointed Christians baptized into, and what life force do they all share?

6. Look! I am sending my messenger, and he must clear up a way before me. And suddenly there will come to His temple the true Lord, whom you people are seeking, and the messenger of the covenant in whom you are delighting. Look! He will certainly come, Yehowah of armies has said. (Malachi 3:1)

[Question] What had Yehowah God promised to send to his people from the time of Malachi, that was fulfilled in Christ?

7. For God loved the world so much that he gave his onlybegotten Son, in order, that everyone exercising faith in him, might not be destroyed, but have everlasting life. (John 3:16)

[Question] How much did Yehowah God love the world of mankind, for what was he willing to sacrifice in their behalf?

[Question] What do all exercising faith in Christ receive from Yehowah God?

8. To the congregation of God that is in Corinth, to you who have been sanctified in union with Christ Jesus, called to be holy ones, together with all who everywhere are calling upon the name of our Lord, Jesus Christ, their Lord and ours. (1 Corinthians 1:2)

[Question] What are all anointed ones called to become before God and Christ?

9. The Christ exists divided. Paul was not impaled for you, was he? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul? (1 Corinthians 1:13)

[Question] Was there grounds for different ones within the congregation to say they belonged to those who taught them the truth?

10" My reason, is that certain men have slipped in who have long ago been appointed by the Scriptures to this judgment, ungodly men, turning the undeserved kindness of our God into an excuse for loose conduct, and proving false to our only Owner and Lord, Jesus Christ. (Jude 1:4)

[Question] Who later slipped into the congregation of God, and what did they turn God's undeserved kindness into?

[Question] Who then, did they prove to be false to?

11. Do not be afraid of the things you are about to suffer.

Look! The Devil will keep on throwing some of you into prison that you may be fully put to the test, and that you may have tribulation ten days. Prove yourself faithful even to death, and I will give you the crown of life. (Revelation 2:10)
