

Ephesians 4:7~ Now to each one of us undeserved kindness was given according to how the Christ measured out the free gift.

- 1· Now to each one of his anointed Christian sons, Yehowah God gave undeserved kindness, according to his will, as he measured this out through Christ. Therefore the gifts of each anointed Christian vary according to this undeserved kindness, given to each one according to God's choosing.

[Question] What is given to each anointed one, through the Holy Spirit?

[Question] What then, varies according to this undeserved kindness?

- 2· For through the undeserved **kindness given** to me, I tell everyone there among you, not to think more of himself than it is necessary to think, but to think so as to have a sound mind, each one as God has distributed to him a measure of faith. (**Romans 12:3**)

[Question] What did Paul encourage his anointed Christian brothers not to think about themselves?

- 3· Since, then, we have **gifts** differing according to the undeserved **kindness given** to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the faith proportioned to us. (**Romans 12:6**)

[Question] How then, should we use these spiritual gifts within the congregation?

- 4· But all these operations the one and the same spirit performs, making a distribution to each one respectively, just as it wills. (**1 Corinthians 12:11**)

[Question] What different operations does the one spirit perform?

- 5· Thanks be to God for his indescribable **free gift**. (**2 Corinthians 9:15**)

[Question] What did Paul want to express thanks to God for, though words failed him for it is so glorious?

- 6· But the manifestation of the spirit, is **given** to each one for a beneficial purpose. (**1 Corinthians 12:7**)

[Question] What manifestation of the spirit is given to each one?

- 7· But by God's undeserved **kindness**, I am what I am. And his undeserved **kindness**, that was toward me, did not prove to be in vain, but I labored in excess of them all, yet not I, but the undeserved **kindness** of God, that is with me. **(1 Corinthians 15:10)**

[Question] How did Paul respond to the measure of undeserved kindness given to him, since it was so great?

- 8· To this end I am indeed working hard, exerting myself in accordance with the operation of him, and which is at work in me, with power. **(Colossians 1:29)**

[Question] How did Paul work along with the spirit within him?
