

**Ephesians 5:1~ Therefore, become imitators of God, as beloved children.**

- 1· Paul now encourages them to become imitators of God, now that they have been chosen for adoption through Christ, and to work at becoming his beloved children. This is the way to put on the new personality, for it is God's personality.**

**[Question]** Since Yehowah God is now the spiritual father of anointed Christians, whom should they now learn to imitate?

- 2· You must accordingly be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect. (Matthew 5:48)**

**[Question]** How fully must anointed Christians put on this new personality?

- 3· Continue becoming merciful, just as your Father is merciful. (Luke 6:36)**

**[Question]** What quality should we demonstrate just like Yehowah does?

- 4· That you may prove yourselves sons of your Father who is in the heavens, since he makes his sun rise upon wicked people and good, and makes it rain upon righteous people and unrighteous. (Matthew 5:45)**

**[Question]** How does Yehowah God work good toward all?

- 5· And all of us, while we with unveiled faces, reflect like mirrors the glory of Yehowah, are transformed into the same image from glory to glory, exactly as done by Yehowah the Spirit. (2 Corinthians 3:18)**

**[Question]** How should we reflect the glorious light of the Holy Spirit upon our faces, toward others around us?

- 6· That you may come to be blameless and innocent, children of God without a blemish, in among a crooked and twisted generation, among whom, you are shining as illuminators in the world. (Philippians 2:15)**

**[Question]** What course are all anointed Christians called to, despite living within a wicked generation?
