

**Ephesians 5:11~** And quit sharing with them in the unfruitful works, that belong to the darkness, but, rather, even be reproving them.

- 1· We as anointed Christians should stop sharing with worldly people in their unfruitful works, works that belong to the darkness of this system of things, ruled over by Satan the Devil. Rather we should be reproving them for these very works, and should be trying to make them see the light of the truth, that they are harmful works of the flesh. You must let your light shine!

**[Question]** Who should anointed Christians stop sharing with at all, and why?

**[Question]** How should we counsel those whose works are works of darkness, and what light should we try to expose to them?

- 2· The night is well along, the day has drawn near. Let us therefore put off the **works** belonging to **darkness**, and let us put on the weapons of the light. (**Romans 13:12**)

**[Question]** Since the day of judgment by our God has drawn close, how should we act?

- 3· He that is **reproving** a man, will afterward find more favor, than he will that is flattering with his tongue. (**Proverbs 28:23**)

**[Question]** What will the man who offers reproof receive, that is better than the one flattering?

- 4· Reprove before all onlookers persons who practice sin, that the rest also may have fear. (**1 Timothy 5:20**)

**[Question]** What should be done before all onlookers to those who practice sin, and why?

- 5· Holding firmly to the faithful word, as respects his art of teaching, that he may be able, both to exhort, by the teaching that is healthful, and to reprove, those who contradict. (**Titus 1:9**)

**[Question]** Why should Timothy hold faithfully to his word of teaching, and what will this enable him to do?

- 6· This witness is true. For this very cause keep on **reproving** them with severity, that they may be healthy in the faith. (**Titus 1:13**)

**[Question]** Why was Titus told to keep reproving the Cretans with severity?

- 7· **All those for whom I have affection, I reprove and discipline. Therefore be zealous and repent. (Revelation 3:19)**

**[Question]** How does Yehowah God treat all those, for whom he has affection?

**[Question]** Therefore, how should anointed ones feel about this?

- 8· **Turn away, turn away, get out of there, touch nothing unclean. Get out from the midst of her, keep yourselves clean, you who are carrying the utensils of Yehowah. (Isaiah 52:11)**

**[Question]** What were the priests instructed to do, regarding unclean things?

- 9· **Accordingly the tribes of Israel sent men to all the tribesmen of Benjamin, saying; What is this bad thing that has been brought about among you? (Judges 20:12)**

**[Question]** What wrong did the other 11 tribes try to correct among the sons of Benjamin?

- 10· **Those who are leaving the Law praise the wicked one, but those who are keeping the Law excite themselves against them. (Proverbs 28:4)**

**[Question]** Who did the ones leaving the Law of God praise?

- 11· **Shun it, do not pass along by it, turn aside from it, and pass along. (Proverbs 4:15)**

**[Question]** What counsel does the congregator give, when confronted with sin?

- 12· **In the twilight, in the evening of the day, at the approach of the night and the gloom. (Proverbs 7:9)**

**[Question]** When do those going to a prostitute go to her?
