Ephesians 5:13~ Now all the things, that are being reproved, are made manifest by the light, for everything that is being made manifest is light.

1. Just as light exposes color, bringing it out of the darkness, so spiritual light exposes wrongdoing, bringing it out of the shadows of human existence, and showing up its true colors, its wickedness.

[Question] How can we illustrate how spiritual light exposes falsehoods?

2. The spiritual light of the Holy Spirit exposes and makes manifest, things that must be reproved, for they are not in harmony with God's spirit. It is the role of all true anointed Christians who possess this light in their lives, to let it shine forth into this darkened world, ruled over by Satan the Devil.

[Question] What does the light of the Holy Spirit make evident to anointed ones possessing it?

[Question] How then, do they let their lights shine before others?

3. For he that practices vile things, hates the light, and does not come to the light, in order, that his works may not be reproved. (John 3:20)

[Question] What does the one practicing vile things stay away from, and why?

4. Hence do not judge anything before the due time, until the Lord comes, who will both bring the secret things of darkness to light, and make the counsels of the hearts manifest, and then each one will have his praise come to him from God. (1 Corinthians 4:5)

[Question] What things will the coming of the Lord make manifest?[Question] What then, will each one receive from God?

5. Your word is a lamp to my foot, and a light to my roadway. (Psalms 119:105)

[Question] What does Yehowah God's word serve as for all mankind?

6. Son of man, what is this proverbial saying, that you people have on the soil of Israel, saying; The days are prolonged,

and every vision has perished? (Ezekiel 12:22)

[Question] What became a proverbial saying in Israel, because Yehowah God was slow to take vengeance on evildoers?

7. But if you are all prophesying and any unbeliever or ordinary person comes in, he is reproved by them all, he is closely examined by all. (1 Corinthians 14:24)

[Question] What kind of spiritual gifts would reprove an unbeliever within the congregation, by hearing them?
