

Ephesians 5:15~ So keep strict watch that how you walk is not as unwise, but as wise persons.

- 1• **Paul now warns these anointed Christians to keep a strict watch upon themselves, as to how they are walking, to see to it, that it is not as unwise, but as wise persons. They can do this by Bible study and prayer, and through good works toward others in need, and also through working on their own new personality.**

[Question] What counsel does Paul now give them, and why?

[Question] What things will keep them fixed firmly upon a fine course in life?

- 2• **Look! I am sending you forth as sheep amidst wolves, therefore prove yourselves cautious as serpents, and yet innocent as doves. ([Matthew 10:16](#))**

[Question] What are anointed Christians like, within Satan the Devil's world all around them, and so how should they act within it?

- 3• **For bodily training is beneficial for a little, but godly devotion is beneficial for all things, as it holds promise of the life now, and that which is to come. ([1 Timothy 4:8](#))**

[Question] Why is spiritual training superior to simple exercise?

- 4• **So, flee from the desires incidental to youth, but pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace, along with those who call upon the Lord out of a clean heart. ([2 Timothy 2:22](#))**

[Question] What desires should young Christians flee from, and why?

[Question] What things though, should they seek out with a clean heart?

- 5• **The man is good who is gracious and is lending. He sustains his affairs with justice. ([Psalms 112:5](#))**

[Question] How does Yehowah God view a man who is gracious and lending freely to others, from his abundance?

- 6• **I have considered my ways, that I may turn back my feet to your reminders. ([Psalms 119:59](#))**

[Question] Why did the Psalmist closely consider his own ways?

- 7• **Thinking ability itself will keep guard over you,**

discernment itself will safeguard you. (Proverbs 2:11)

[Question] What will guard the spiritual man?

- 8· Smooth out the course of your foot, and may all your own ways be firmly established. (Proverbs 4:26)**

[Question] What course are we counseled to take, to what end?

- 9· Foolishness is a rejoicing to one who is in want of heart, but the man of discernment, is one who goes straight ahead. (Proverbs 15:21)**

[Question] What was does the man of discernment walk?

- 10· So stay in that house, eating and drinking the things they provide, for the worker is worthy of his wages. Do not be transferring from house to house. (Luke 10:7)**

[Question] What counsel did Jesus give to his disciples, when going forth to preach the word?

- 11· Do not be loving either the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. (1 John 2:15)**

[Question] What should anointed Christians not be loving, for what is God directly opposed to?

- 12· Become watchful, and strengthen the things remaining that were ready to die, for I have not found your deeds fully performed before my God. (Revelation 3:2)**

[Question] What counsel did the resurrected Jesus Christ give to the congregations spiritually?
