

Ephesians 5:17~ On this account, cease becoming unreasonable, but go on perceiving, what the will of Yehowah¹ is.

1• On this account we cannot afford to ever be unreasonable, but always reasonable. We need to continually seek to know more about Yehowah's grand purpose, through a thorough study of his word the Bible, and through prayer, for it is through prayer and the work of the spirit, that most new understanding will come forth to God's anointed sons.

[Question] What must we alongside be toward all others?

[Question] What things should we always be trying to know more about, and how can we do this?

2• We must also discuss and reason out with one another, all the matters of faith, and continually revise our understanding with discussions among one another. Thus we will cease to become unreasonable, or dogmatic.

[Question] What matters are proper matters for spiritual discussions among anointed Christians?

[Question] What should always be avoided?

3• Teach me to do your **will**, for you are my God. Your spirit is good. May it lead me in the land of uprightness. (**Psalms 143:10**)

[Question] What did the Psalmist ask God to teach him, and why was this so desirable?

4• In that case you **will** understand the fear of **Yehowah**, and you **will** find the very knowledge of God. (**Proverbs 2:5**)

[Question] What should all be seeking to find in life?

5• If anyone desires to do His **will**, he **will** know concerning the teaching, whether it is from God, or **whether** I speak of my own originality. (**John 7:17**)

[Question] What discernment will those desiring to do God's will have?

6• And quit being fashioned after this system of things, but **be**

transformed by making your mind over, that you may prove to yourselves the good and acceptable and perfect will of God. (Romans 12:2)

[Question] What should anointed Christians not be fashioned after?

[Question] What do they need to change over to God's way of thinking, and prove to themselves through reasoning?

- 7· **For this is what God wills, the sanctifying of you, that you abstain from fornication. (1 Thessalonians 4:3)**

[Question] What is God's will for all his anointed sons, and so what must they abstain from?

- 8· **In connection with everything give thanks. For this is the will of God in union with Christ Jesus respecting you. (1 Thessalonians 5:18)**

[Question] What is it God's will for his anointed sons to always do and express?

- 9· **To the end that he may live the remainder of his time in the flesh, no more for the desires of men, but for God's will. (1 Peter 4:2)**

[Question] For what should we live the remainder of our time in the flesh?

- 10· **Hence brace up your minds for activity, keep your senses completely. Set your hope upon the undeserved kindness, that is to be brought to you, at the revelation of Jesus Christ. (1 Peter 1:13)**

[Question] What should anointed Christians brace up their minds for, and set their sole hope upon?

- 11· **So as to pay attention to wisdom with your ear, that you may incline your heart to discernment. (Proverbs 2:2)**

[Question] What will paying attention to divine wisdom incline our hearts toward?

- 12· **The wisdom of the shrewd is to understand his way, but the foolishness of stupid ones is deception. (Proverbs 14:8)**

[Question] What is the wisdom of the shrewd one?

- 13· Yes, for the path of your judgments, O Yehowah, we have hoped in you. For your name, and for your memorial, the desire of the soul has been. (Isaiah 26:8)**

[Question] What do the servants of Yehowah God hope in, and for?

- 14· You have depended upon your sword. You have done a detestable thing, and you have defiled each one the wife of his companion. So should you possess the land? (Ezekiel 33:26)**

[Question] What question does Yehowah God ask about wicked ones?
