

Ephesians 5:24~ In fact, as the congregation is in subjection to the Christ, so let wives also be to their husbands in everything.

1· In the same way as the congregation is in subjection to the Christ, so wives should be to their husbands in all things. Would you argue with Christ or make a scene before him? Would you go against his wishes for you, brazenly taking matters of control out of his hands, and doing whatever you wanted to do against his wishes? The rule is; If you would not do it before Christ, then do not do it before your husband, it is shameful conduct! Let familiarity not breed disrespect in you, and do not take liberties because of it.

2· As Sarah used to obey Abraham, calling him **lord**. And you have become her children, provided you keep on doing good, and not fearing any cause for terror. (**1 Peter 3:6**)

3· Let the women keep silent in the **congregations**, for it is not permitted for them to speak, but **let** them be in **subjection**, even as the Law says. (**1 Corinthians 14:34**)

[Question] What is the role of Christian women within the congregation of God?

4· Immediately the woman hurried and ran and told her husband and said to him; Look! The man that came the other day to me has appeared to me. (**Judges 13:10**)

[Question] What did the wife of Manoah convey to her husband?

5· But Queen Vashti kept refusing to come at the king's word that was conveyed by means of the court officials. At this

the king grew highly indignant and his very rage flared up within him. (Esther 1:12)

[Question] Why did Vashti experience the king's wrath?

- 6· The wife does not exercise authority over her own body, but her husband does, likewise, also, the husband does not exercise authority over his own body, but his wife does. (1 Corinthians 7:4)**

[Question] Who exercises authority over the wife's body?

[Question] Who exercises authority over the husband's body?

- 7· Let a woman learn in silence with full submissiveness. (1 Timothy 2:11)**
