Ephesians 5:26~ That he might sanctify it, cleansing it with the bath of water by means of the word.

1. Christ gave his life for the congregation of anointed ones so as to sanctify it before him, and his God, making it clean and honorable, fit for marriage. This he did by cleansing it through the bath of the word, and so Christian husbands must study with their wives from the Bible, and this should start while they are still engaged to marry, even if they are in the Way, for women should not speak within a congregation by way of teaching, but should learn at home through their husbands.

2. Hence Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered outside the gate. (Hebrews 13:12)

3. Sanctify them by means of the truth, your word is truth. (John 17:17)

[Question] What word sanctifies anointed Christians, and what is that word?

4. And Aaron and his sons must wash their hands and their feet at it. (Exodus 30:19)

[Question] What were the priests to do before entering the tent of meeting?

5. Then you must bring Aaron and his sons near to the entrance of the tent of meeting and wash them with water. (Exodus 40:12)

**[Question]** What was part of the installation of the priesthood?

6. So Moses brought Aaron and his sons near and washed them with water. (Leviticus 8:6)

[Question] What did Moses do to install the priesthood?

7. For on this day atonement will be made for you to pronounce you clean. You will be clean from all your sins before Yehowah. (Leviticus 16:30)

[Question] How were those under the Law Covenant viewed on the Day of Atonement?

8. And as regards your birth, on the day of your being born your navel string had not been cut, and in water you had not been washed for cleansing, and with salt you had not at all been rubbed, and by no means had you been swaddled. (Ezekiel 16:4)

[Question] How does Yehowah God illustrate, how he cleansed his people for his service early on?

9. Son of man, say to her, you are a land not being cleansed, one not rained down upon in the day of denunciation. (Ezekiel 22:24)

[Question] What had the land of Yehowah people become, through repeated wickedness?

10" There were four tables over here and four tables over there at the side of the gate, eight tables, upon which they would do the slaughtering. (Ezekiel 40:41)

[Question] What was part of the visionary temple on the corners of the courtyard?

11. Peter said to him; You will certainly never wash my feet.

Jesus answered him; Unless I wash you, you have no part with me. (John 13:8)

[Question] What did Peter try to stop Jesus Christ from doing to him, and why did he change his mind about it?

12. Every branch in me not bearing fruit he takes away, and every one bearing fruit he cleans, that it may bear more fruit. (John 15:2)

[Question] What happens to every branch in Christ, that is not bearing fruit?

13. And yet that is what some of you were. But you have been washed clean, but you have been sanctified, but you have been declared righteous, in the name of our Lord Jesus

Christ, and with the spirit of our God. (1 Corinthians 6:11)

[Question] What were some anointed Christians before becoming Christians, and how were they sanctified?

14. For this is what God wills, the sanctifying of you, that you abstain from fornication. (1 Thessalonians 4:3)

[Question] What does God will for his sons, and why is this so important, if they are going to marry his foremost son?

15. Let us approach with true hearts in the full assurance of faith, having had our hearts sprinkled from a wicked conscience and our bodies bathed with clean water. (Hebrews 10:22)
