- 1· **No man hurts his own flesh, but he feeds and cherishes it. This is the same thing, that the Christ does to the congregation, and a man is responsible to feed his wife, not only materially, but more importantly, spiritually.**

- 2· **But the married man is anxious for the things of the world, how he may gain the approval of his wife. (1 Corinthians 7:33)**

[Question] What is the married man anxious for, as opposed to the single man?

- 3· **If he should take another wife for himself, her sustenance, her clothing and her marriage due, are not to be diminished. (Exodus 21:10)**

[Question] What was not to be diminished, if a man had more than one wife?
