Ephesians 5:29~ For no man ever hated his own flesh, but he feeds and cherishes it, as the Christ also does the congregation.

1. No man hurts his own flesh, but he feeds and cherishes it. This is the same thing, that the Christ does to the congregation, and a man is responsible to feed his wife, not only materially, but more importantly, spiritually.

[Question] How do men treat their own bodies, and so how should they treat their wives?

[Question] In what fine ways is a man responsible for taking care of his wife?

2. But the married man is anxious for the things of the world, how he may gain the approval of his wife. (1 Corinthians 7:33)

[Question] What is the married man anxious for, as opposed to the single man?

3. If he should take another wife for himself, her sustenance, her clothing and her marriage due, are not to be diminished. (Exodus 21:10)

[Question] What was not to be diminished, if a man had more than one wife?
