

Ephesians 5:33~ Nevertheless, also, let each one of you individually so love his wife as he does himself, on the other hand, the wife should have deep respect for her husband.

- 1• **Paul now counsels, that each man should individually love his wife, as he does his own body. Also the wife should have deep respect for her husband, like that of Sarah.**

[Question] How then, should a man love his wife, and how should the woman feel about her husband?

- 2• **You **husbands**, keep on loving your wives and do not be bitterly angry with them. (**Colossians 3:19**)**

[Question] How should husbands treat their wives, and what should they not feel towards them?

- 3• **As Sarah used to obey Abraham, calling him **lord**. And you **have** become her children, provided you keep on doing good, and not fearing any cause for terror. (**1 Peter 3:6**)**

[Question] How did Sarah feel about her husband Abraham, and who become her spiritual children, and how?

- 4• **In case a man takes a **wife** and actually has relations with her and has come to hate her. (**Deuteronomy 22:13**)**

[Question] What was the Law governing an engaged woman, who was found not to be a virgin?

- 5• **David now returned to bless his own household, and Michal, Saul's daughter, came on out to meet David and then said; How glorious the king of Israel made himself today when he uncovered himself today to the eyes of the slave girls of his servants, just as one of the empty-headed men uncovers himself outright! (**2 Samuel 6:20**)**

[Question] How did Michal come to view David, when he danced joyously at the bringing in of the Ark of the Covenant to Jerusalem?

- 6• **And the decree of the king, that he will make, must be heard in all his realm, for it is vast, and all the wives themselves will give honor to their owners, the great as well as the small. (**Esther 1:20**)**

[Question] What command did the king of Persia make, to all those within his realm?

- 7· **Are you bound to a wife? Stop seeking a release. Are you loosed from a wife? Stop seeking a wife. (1 Corinthians 7:27)**

[Question] What should one bound to a wife, though unbelieving, stop seeking?
